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Introduction

This document is an update of material first published by Boulder County Aging Services Division in April 1993. Using data from the U. S. Census 2000 and its supplements, the Colorado Demographer's Website, and miscellaneous other sources as cited, this booklet presents demographic information pertaining primarily to the 60+ population of Boulder County.

It should be noted that, wherever possible, we have presented data describing the population age 60 and over. However, census data is collected in a variety of age increments, with age 65 being used as a key age break. Therefore, many charts and tables reflect the census convention of under/over age 65, rather than age 60+.

Boulder County Aging Services Division is the designated Area Agency on Aging for Boulder County. As such, we plan, develop, fund, coordinate, and evaluate services for persons 60 and over and their caregivers. Our mission is:

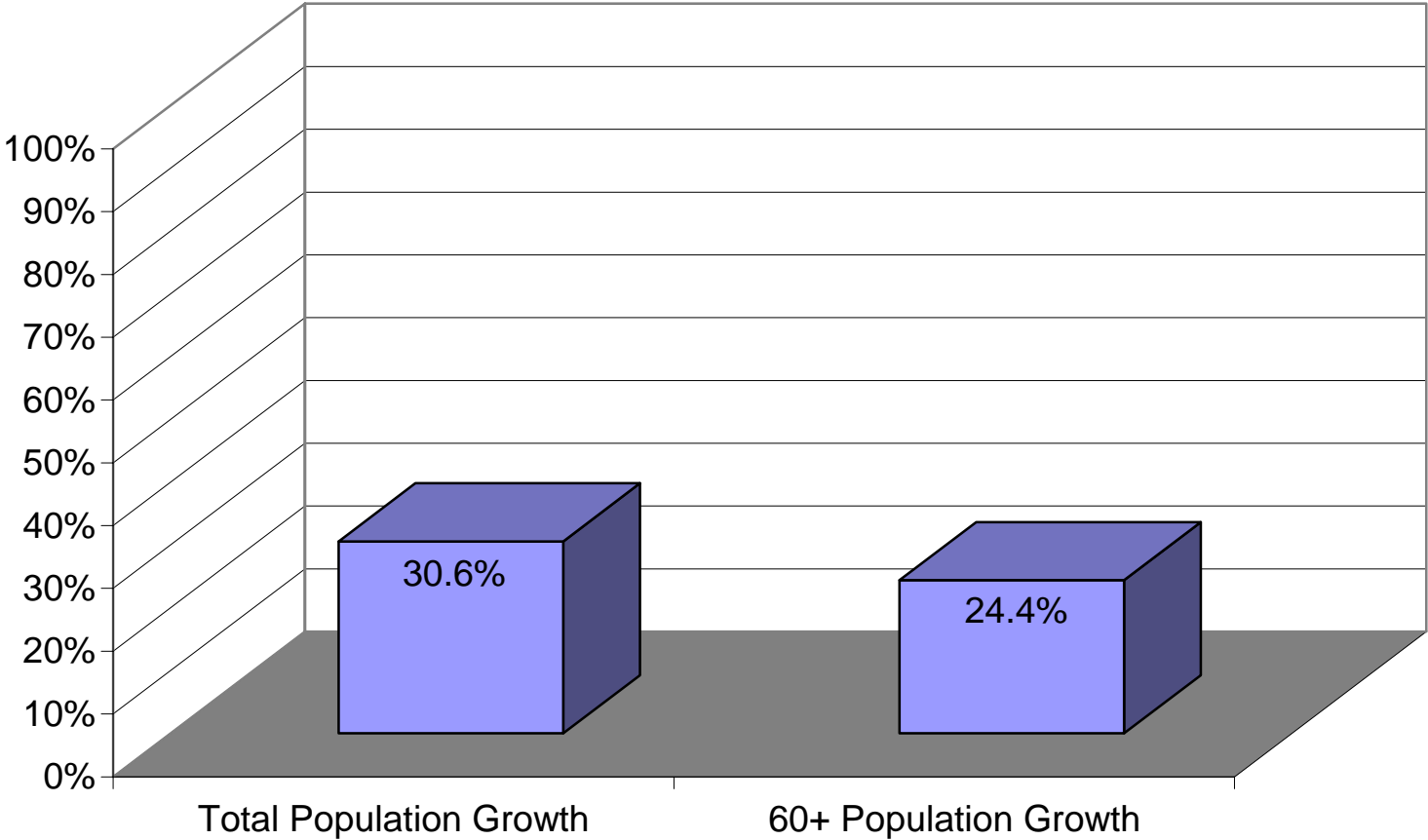

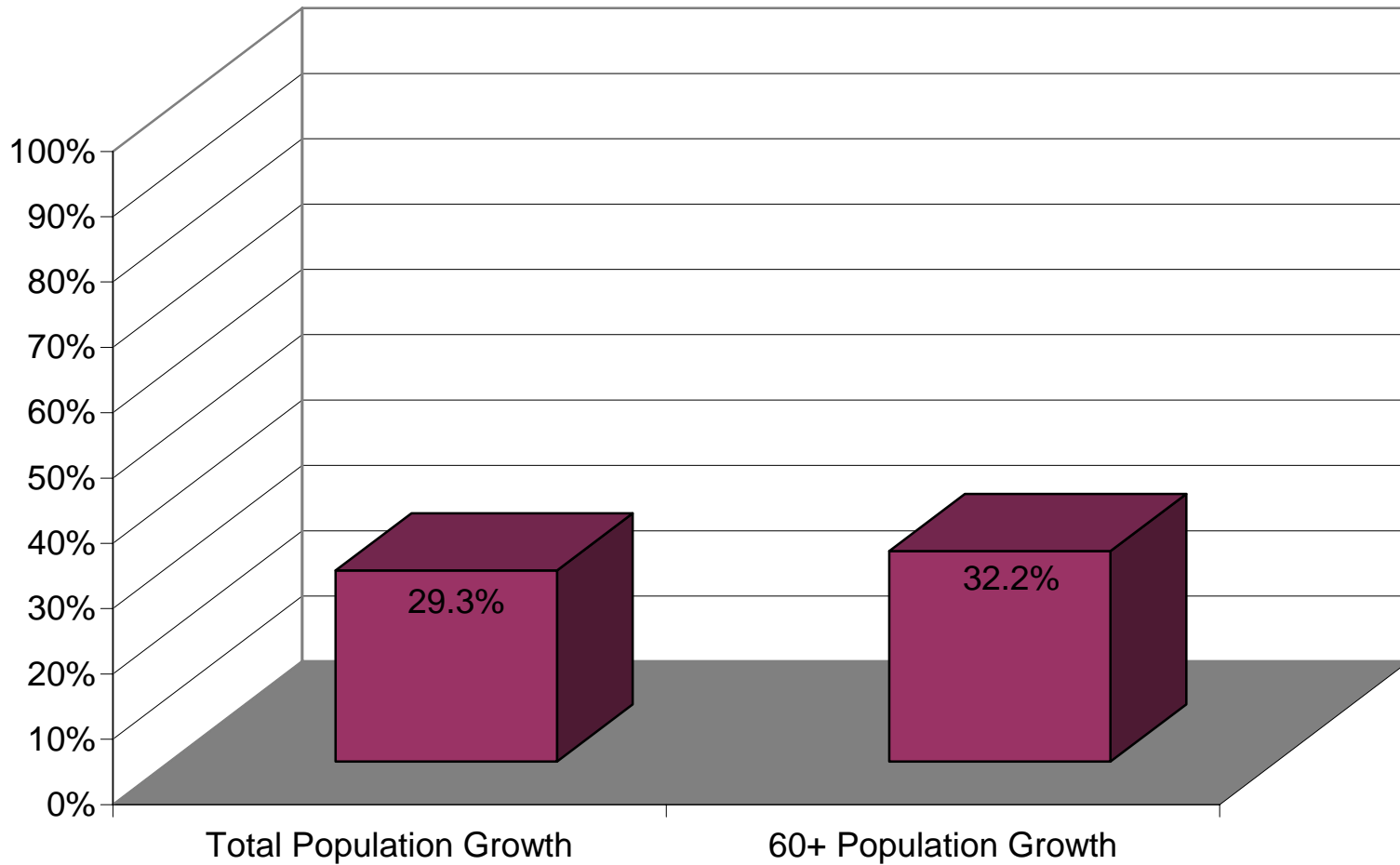

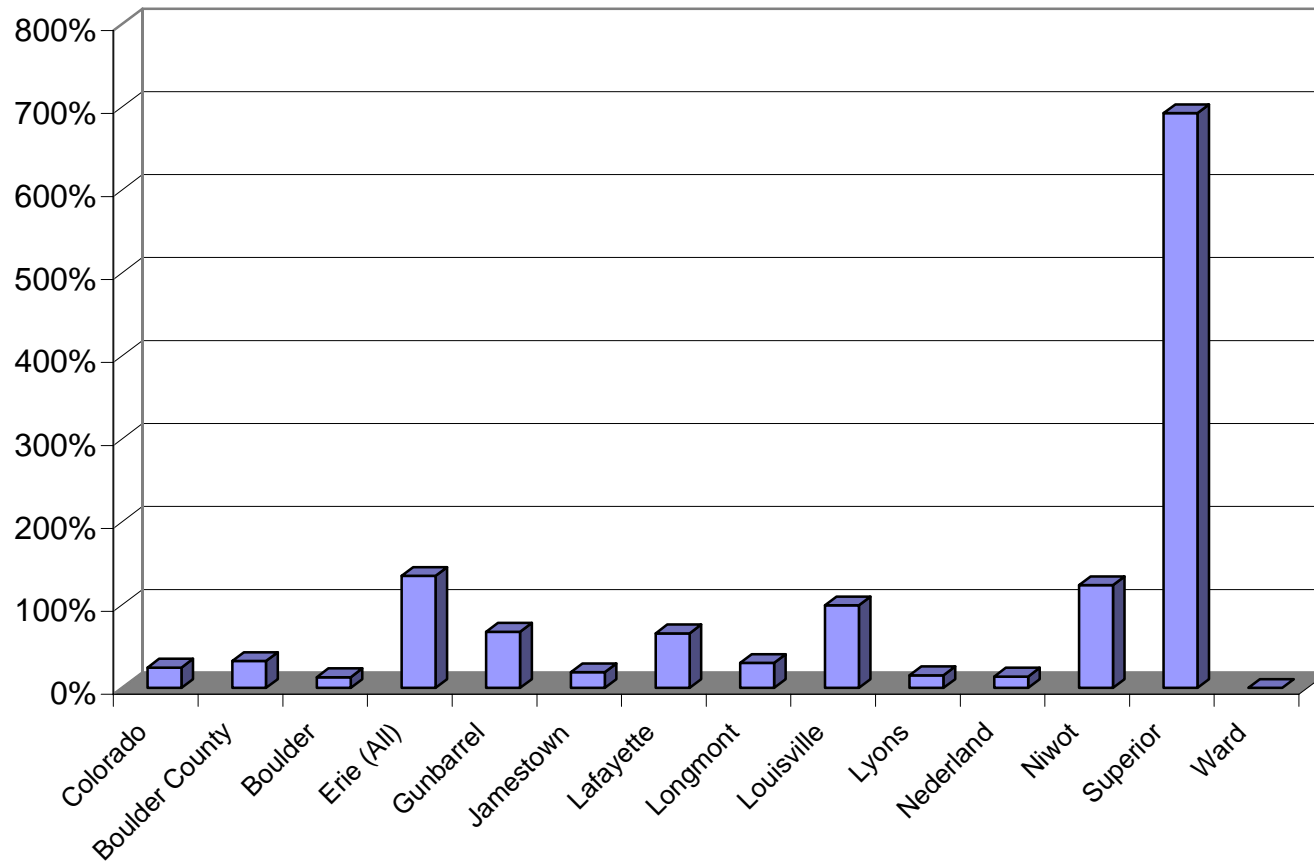

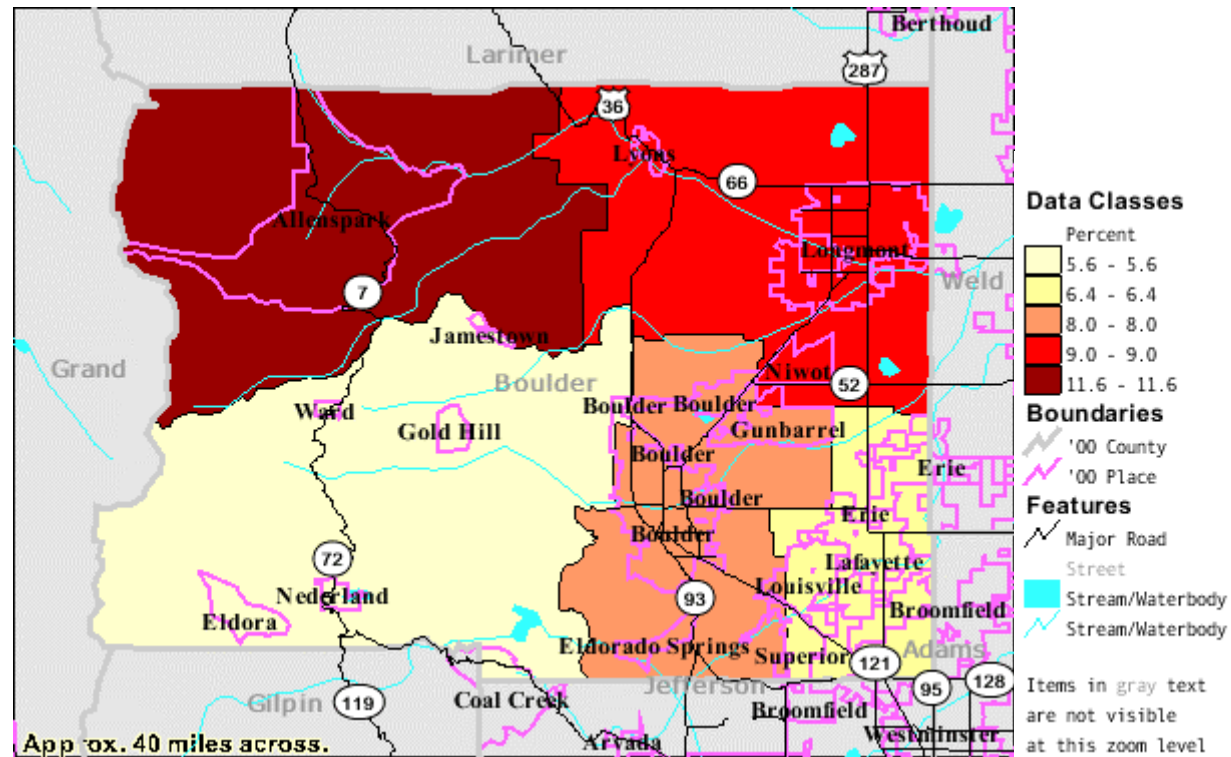

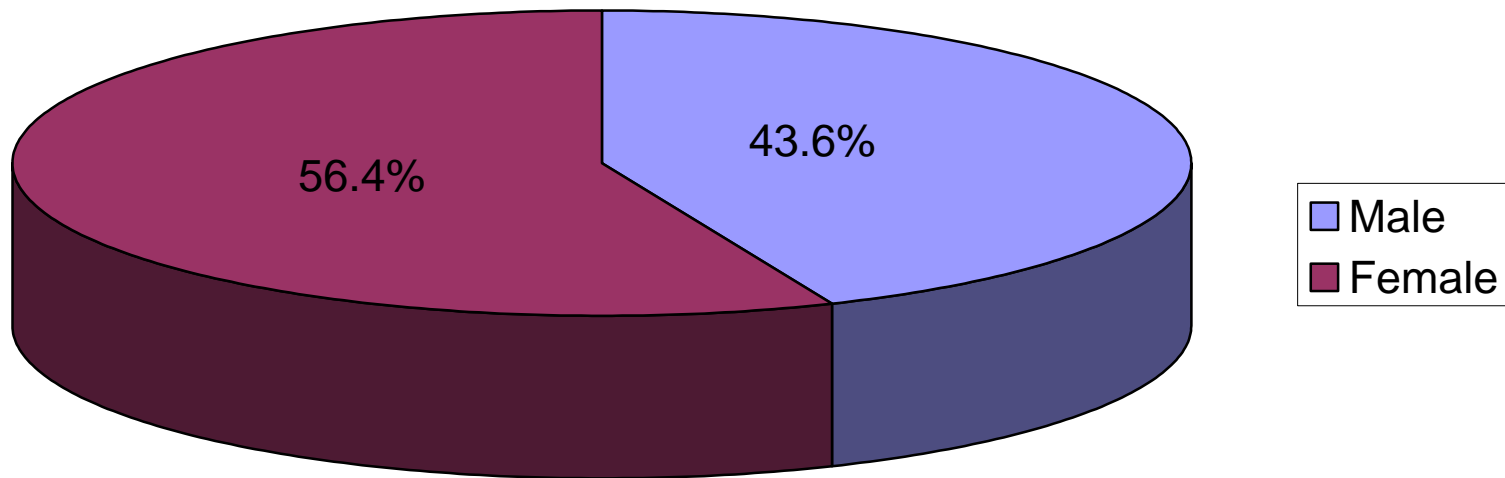

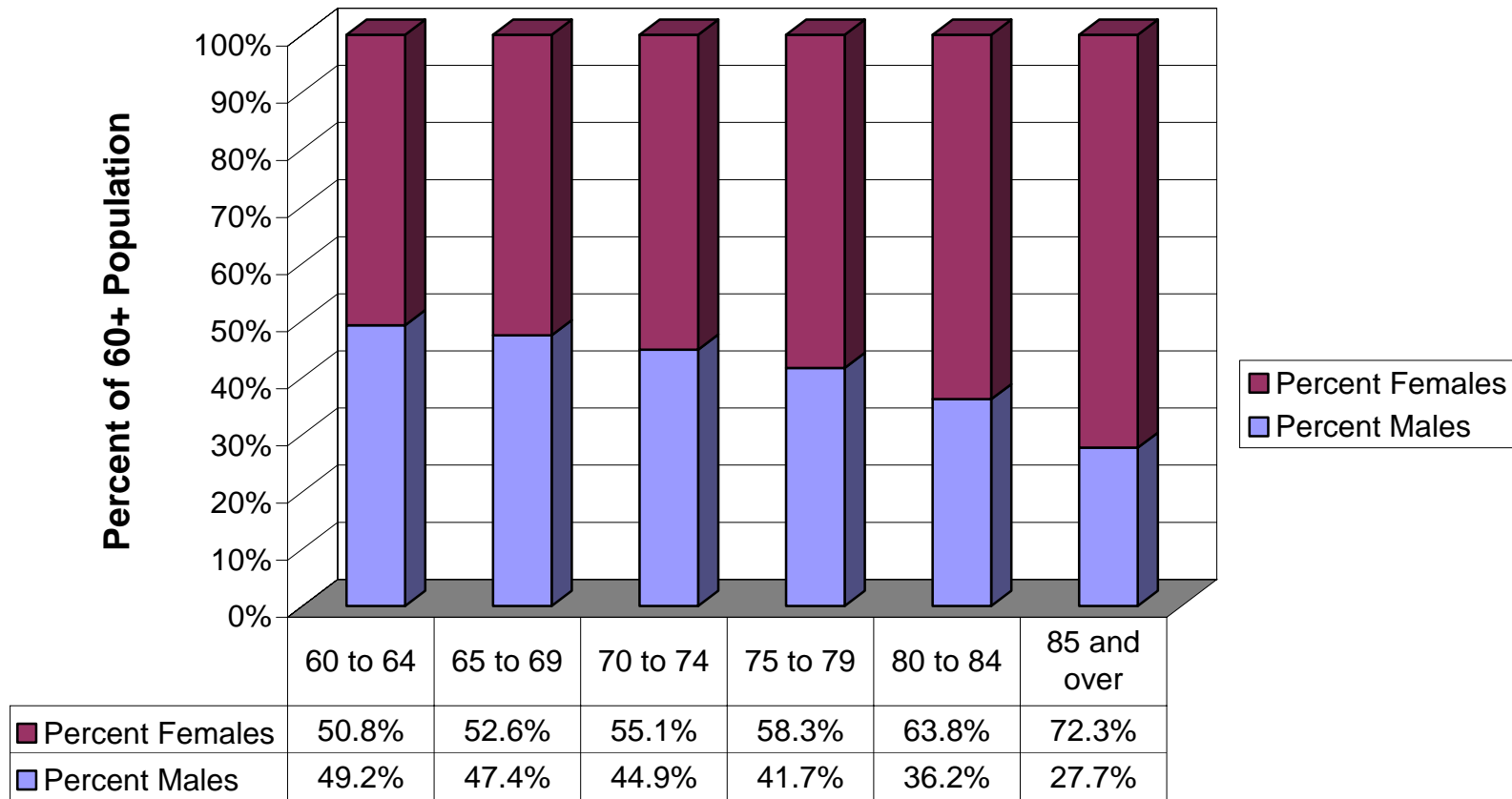

Boulder County Percent of 60+ Population by Gender 2000



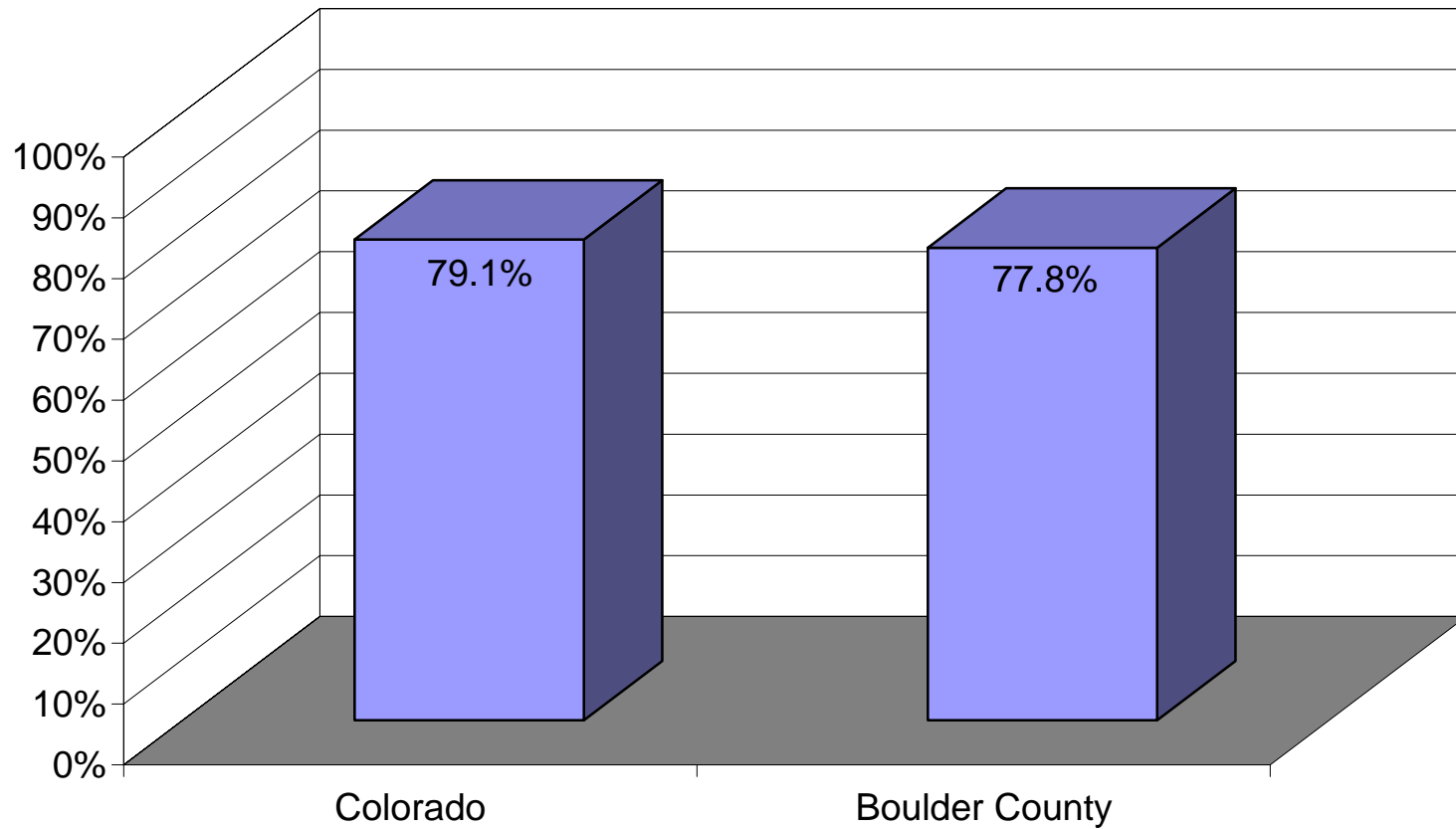

Boulder County 60+ Population by Age and Gender 2000



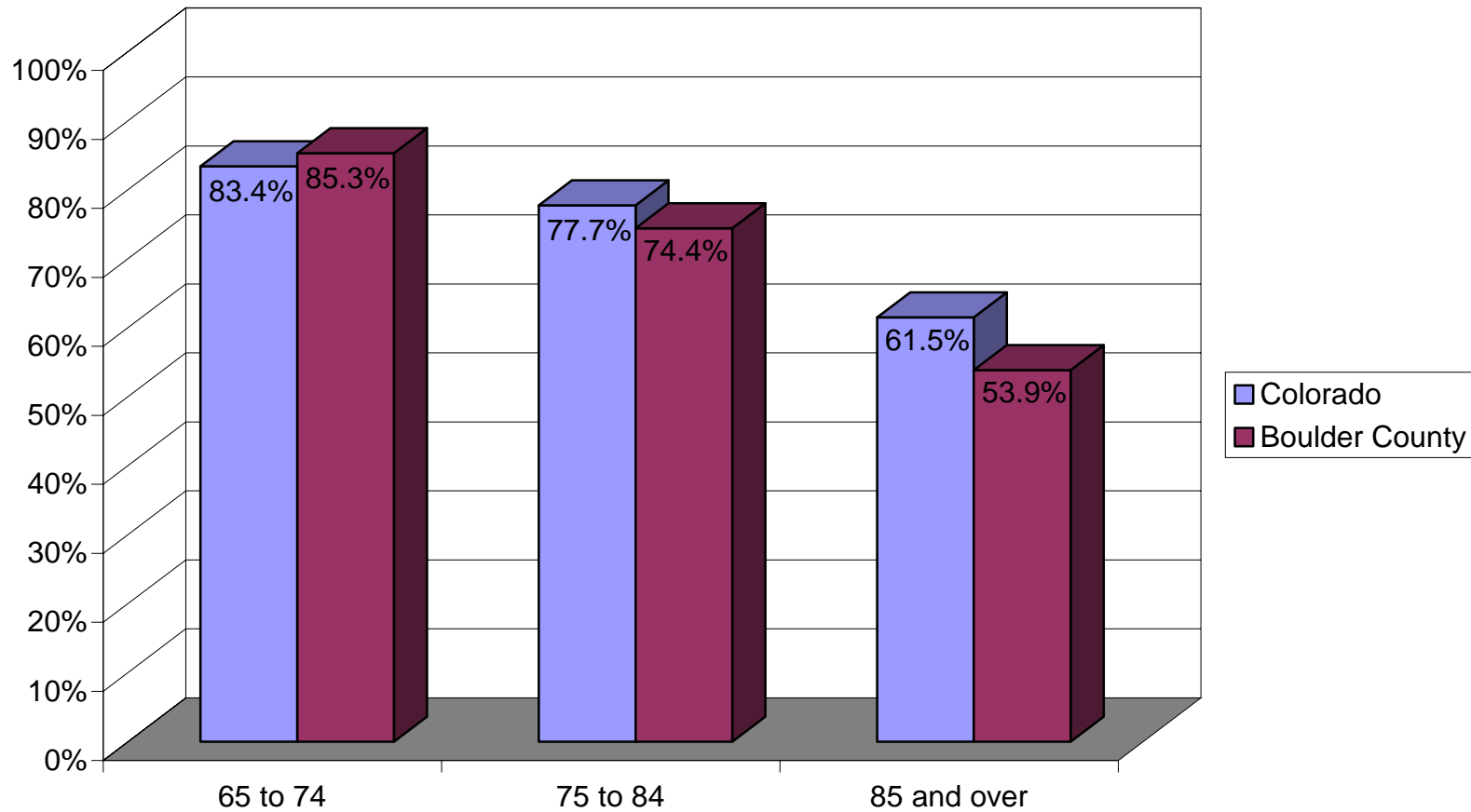

Colorado and Boulder County 65+ Home Ownership 2000



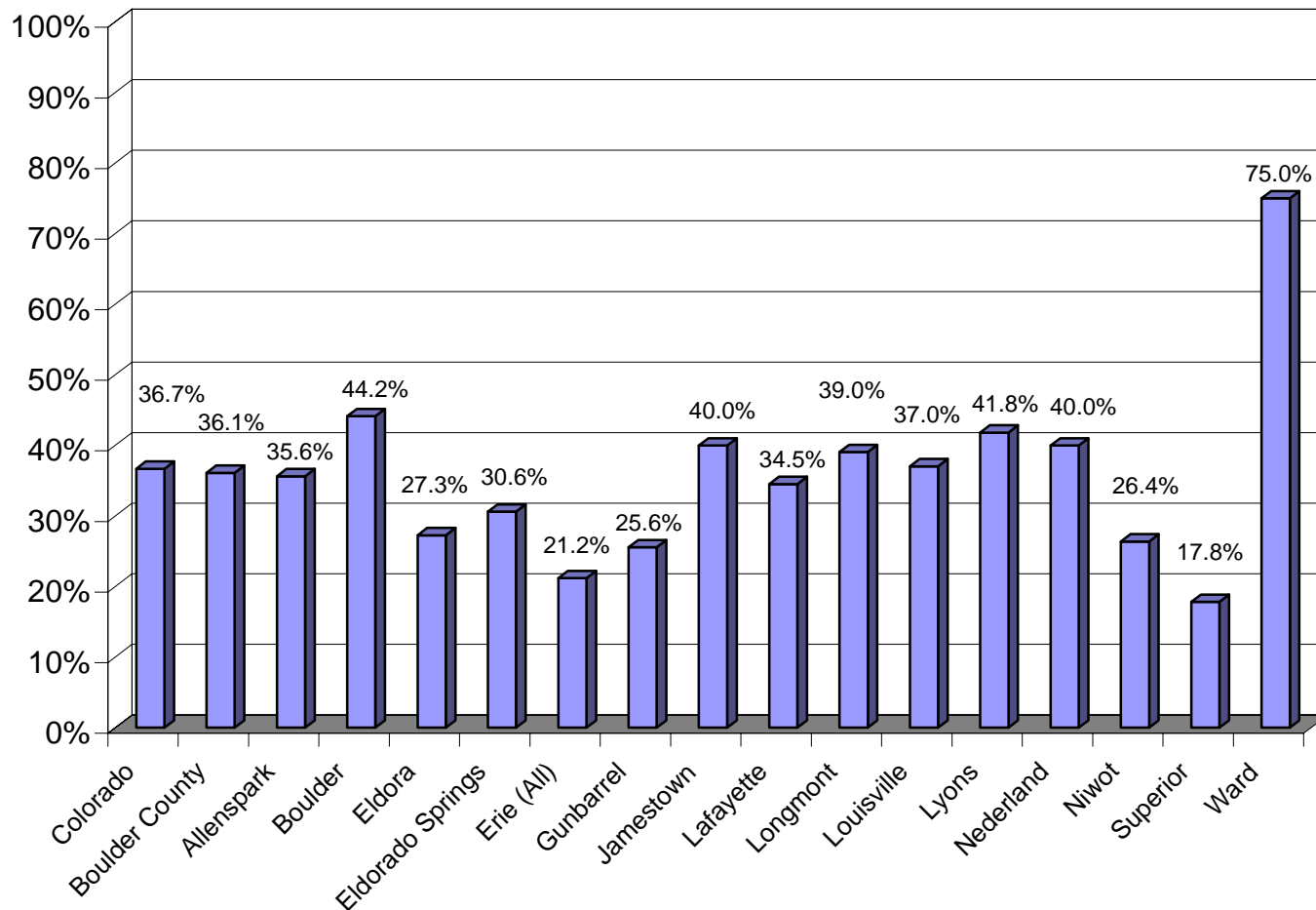

Colorado and Boulder County 65+ Home Ownership by Age Range 2000



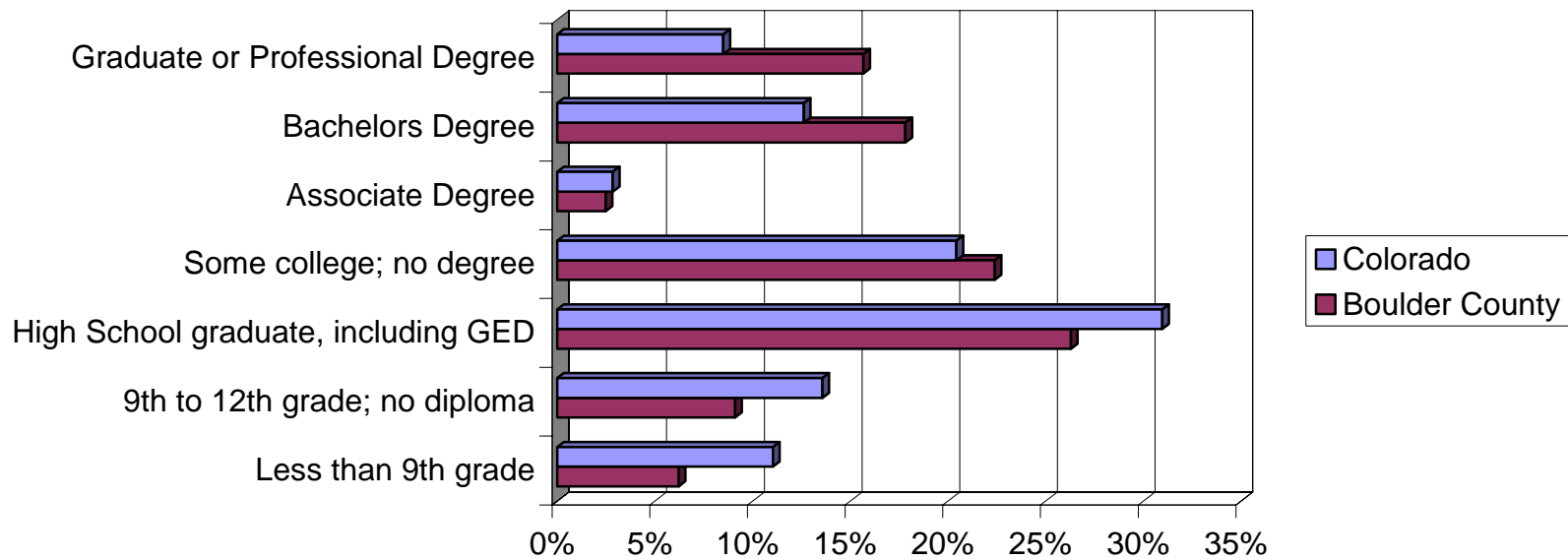

Percent of 60+ Population Living Alone 2000



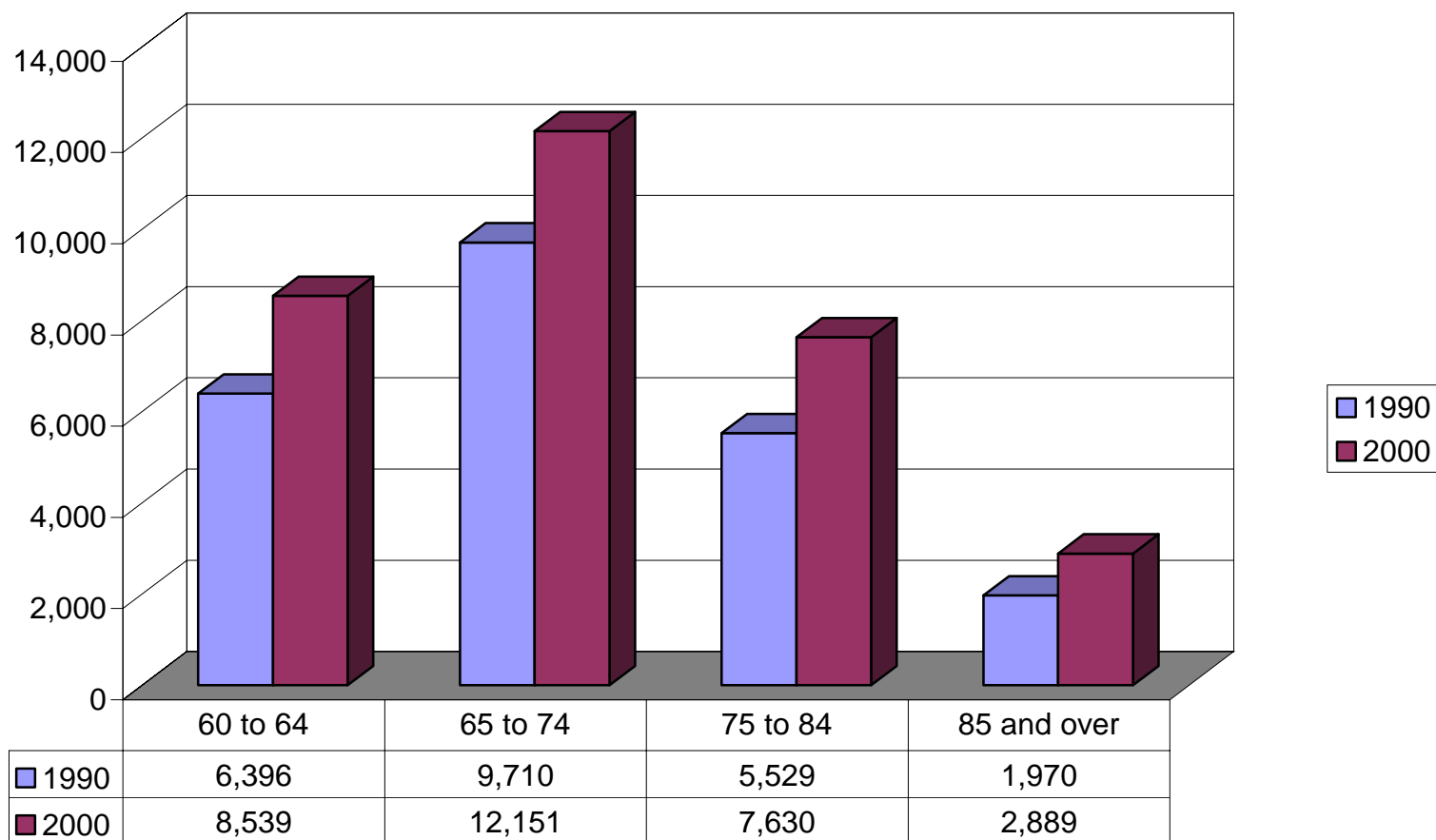

Colorado and Boulder County 65+ Educational Attainment 2000



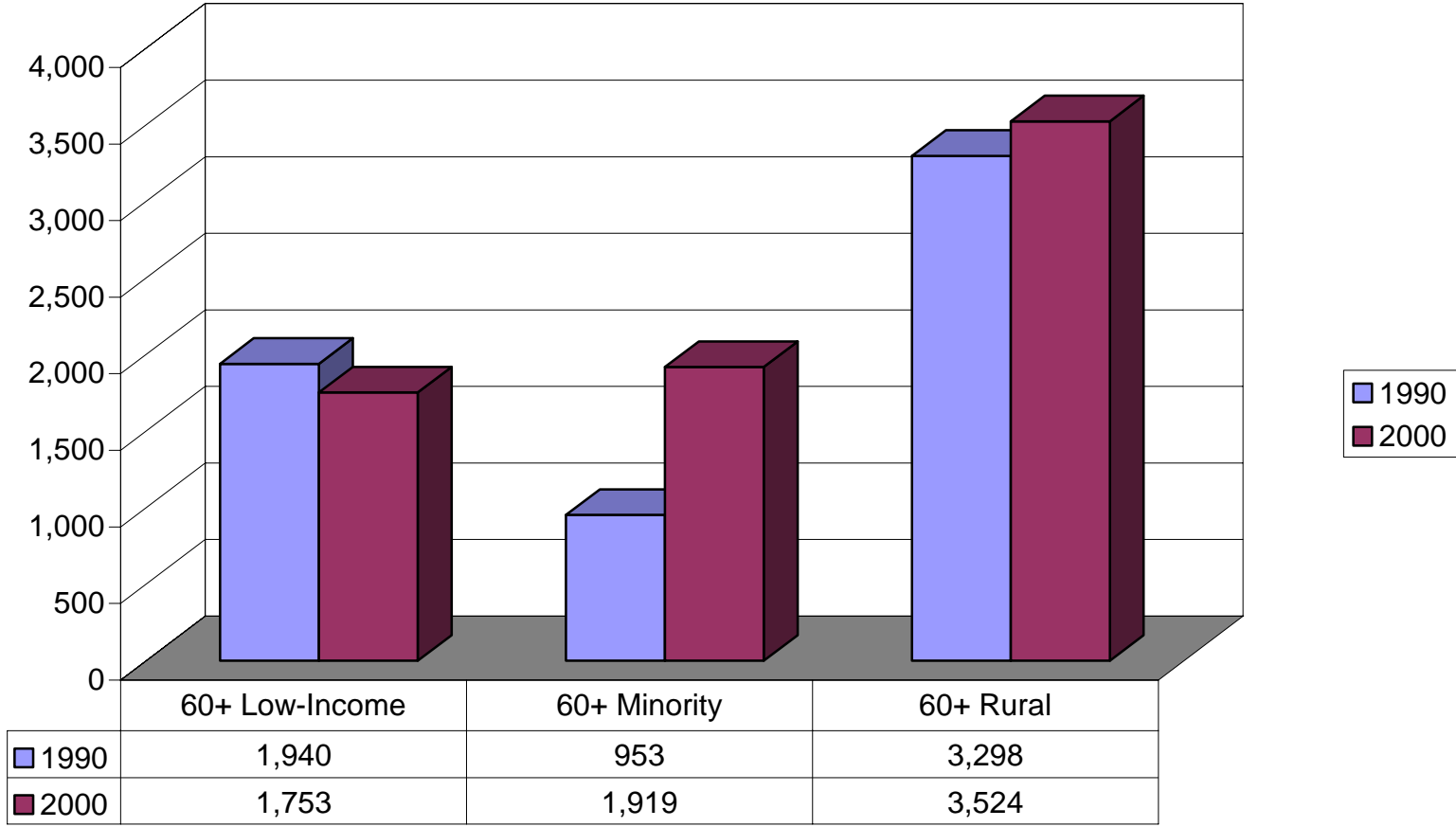

Boulder County 60+ Population – Key Age Groups 1990 – 2000



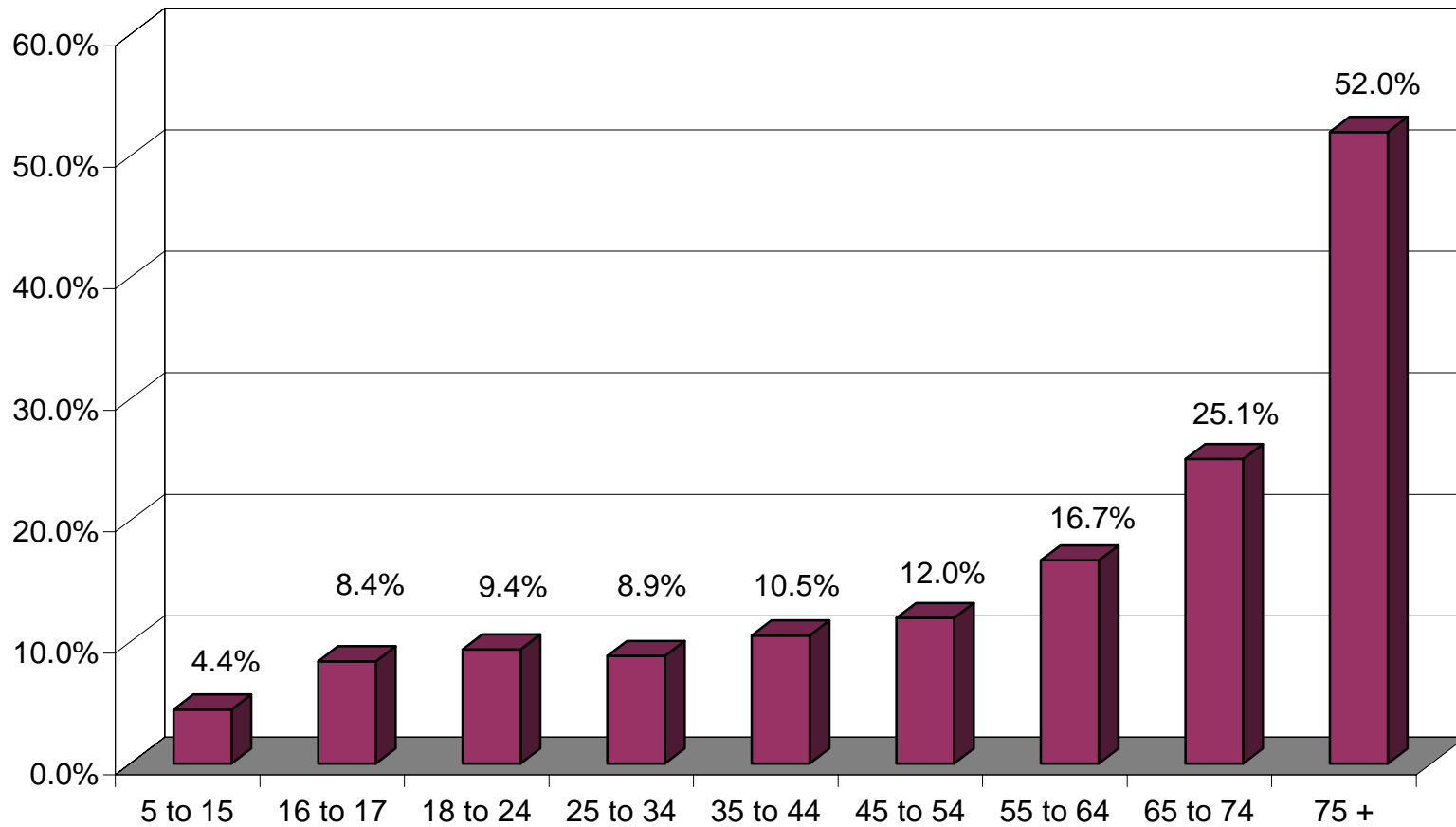

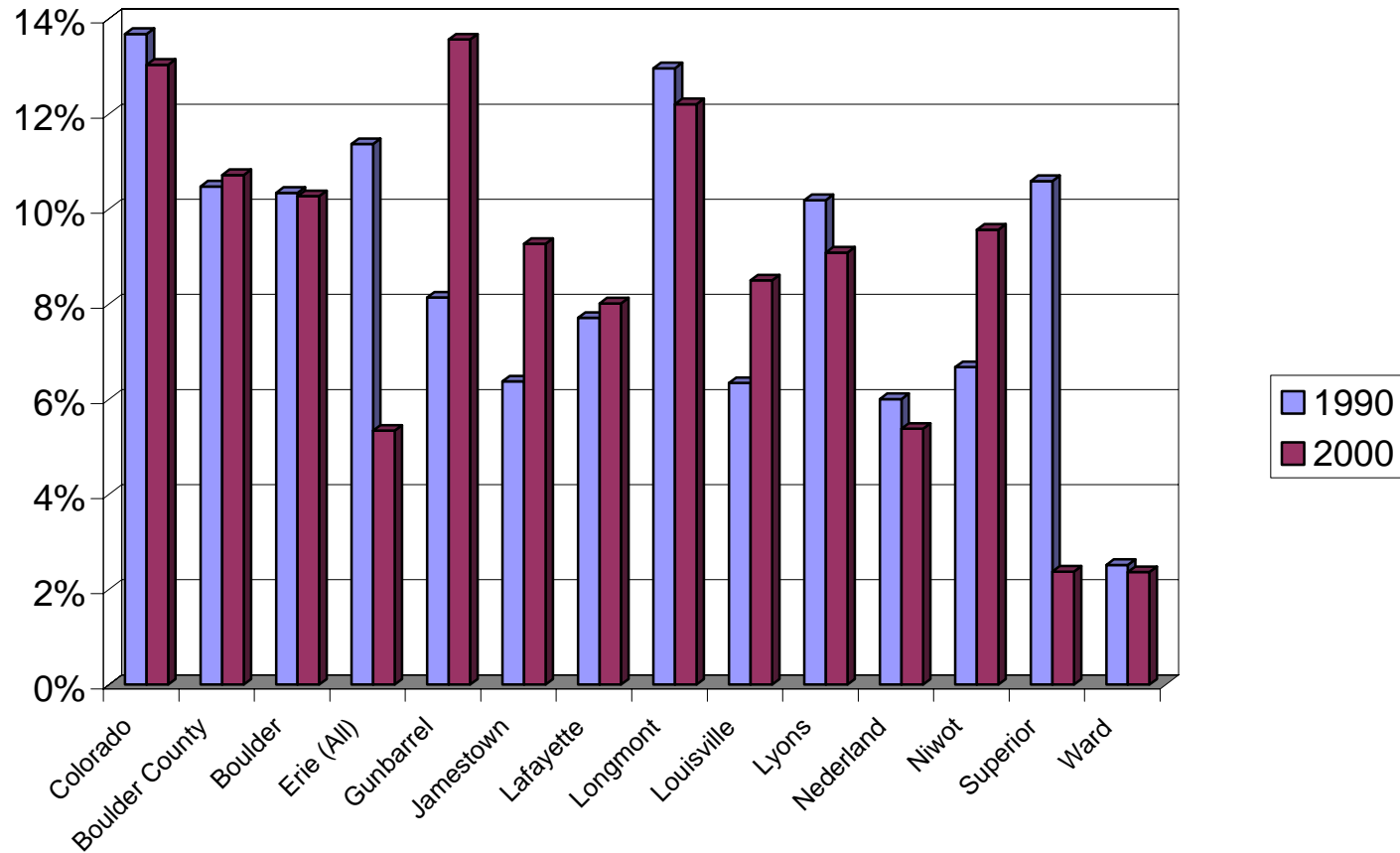

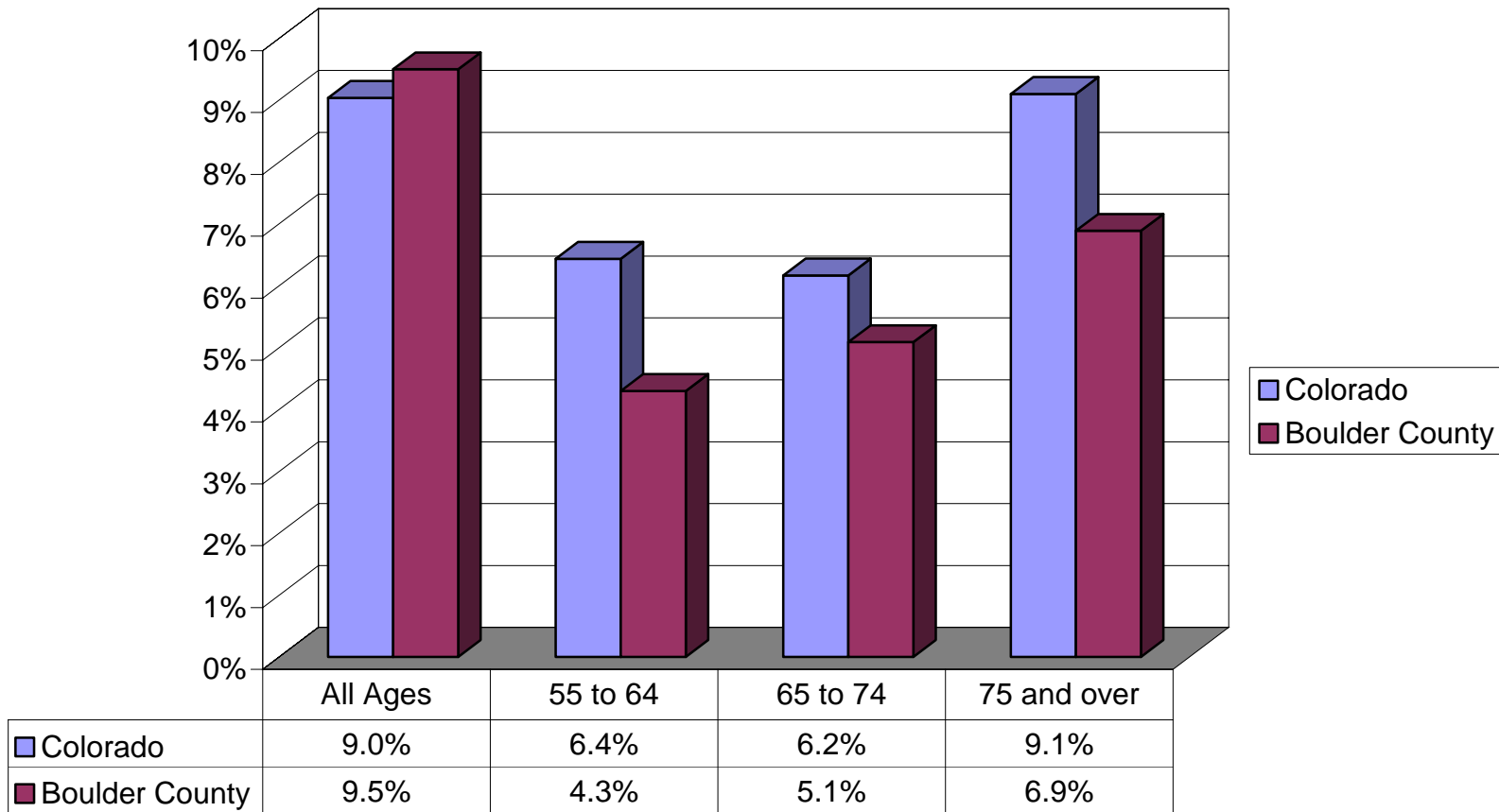

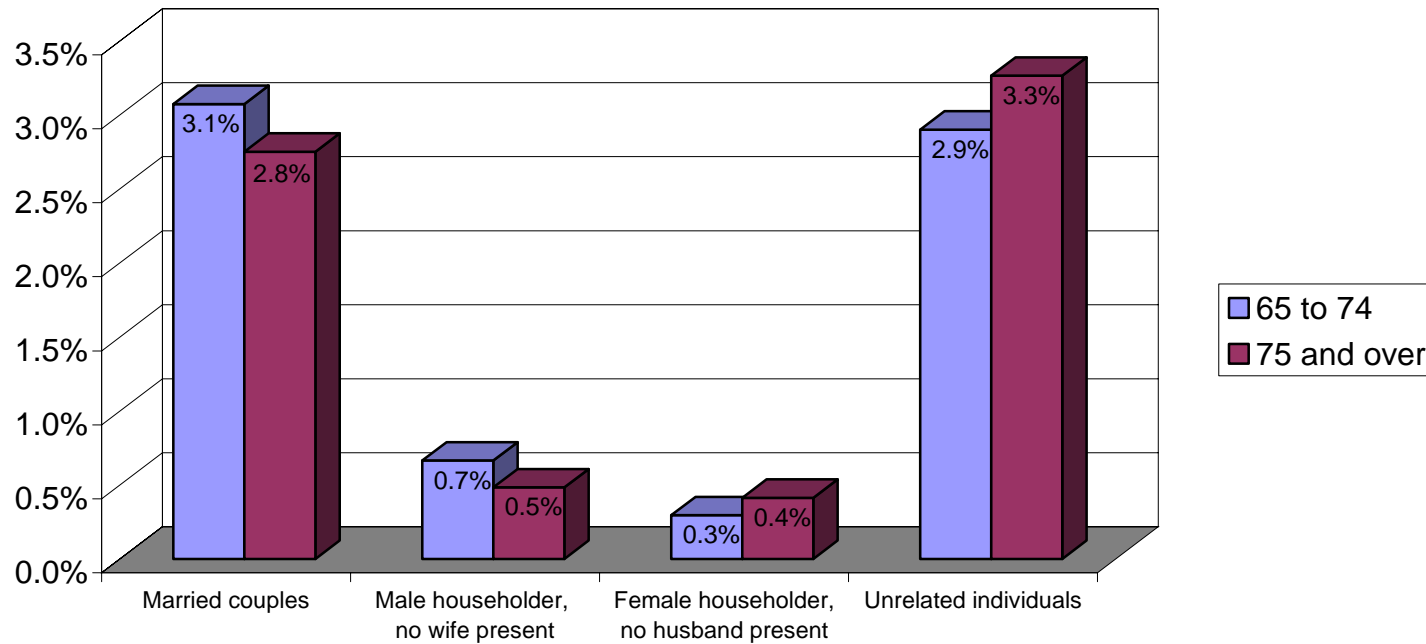
Percent of Population Below Poverty Level by Age Group 1999

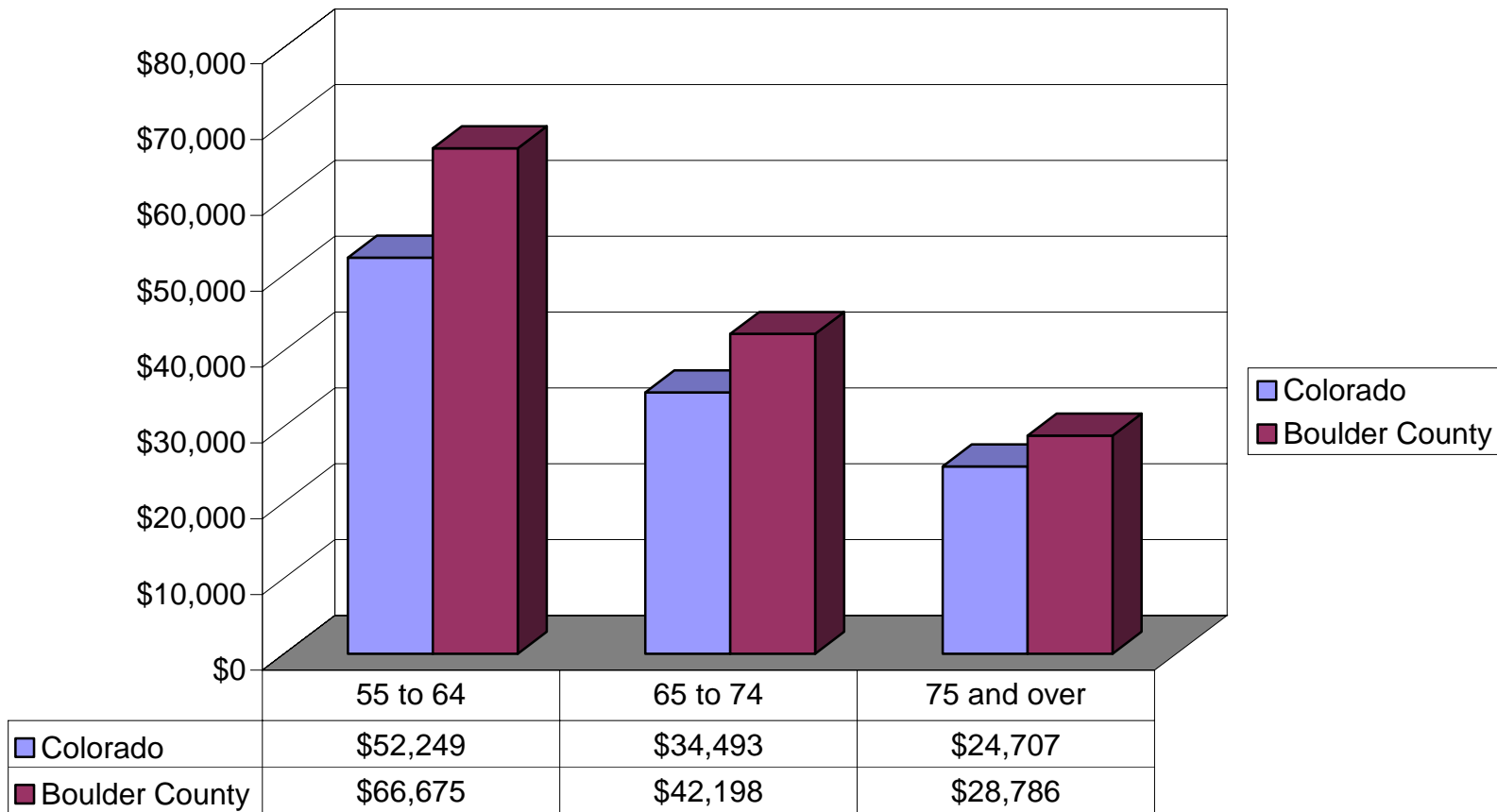

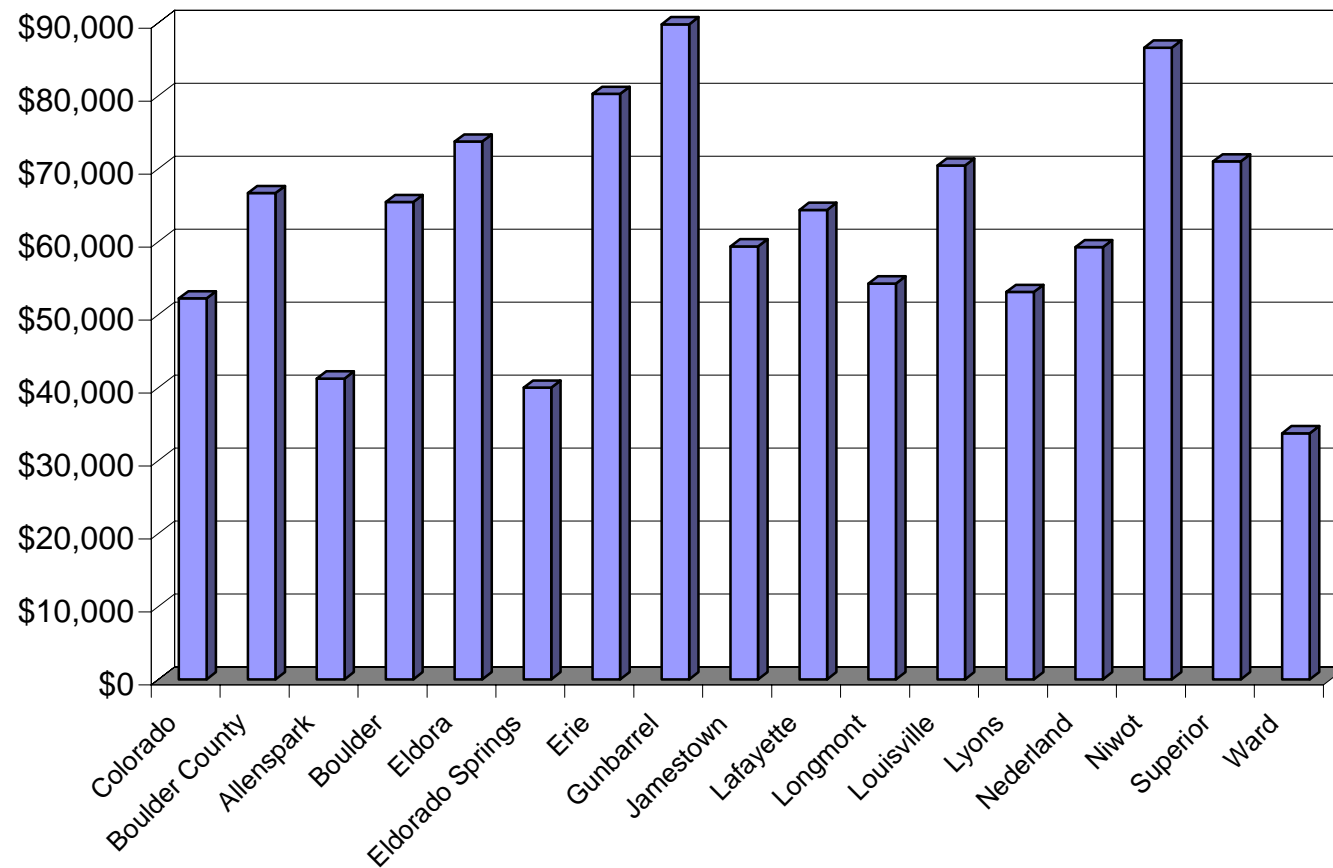

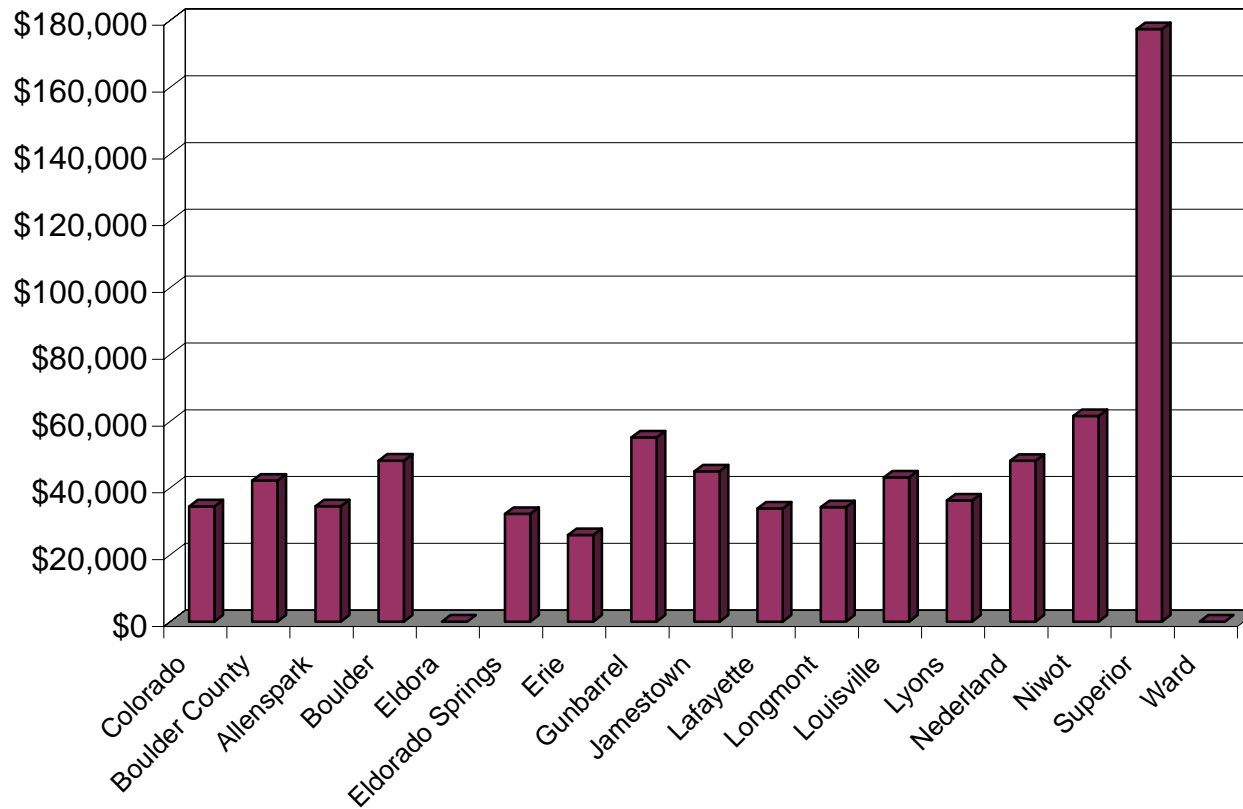

Median Household Income by Community – 55 to 64 Age Group 1999



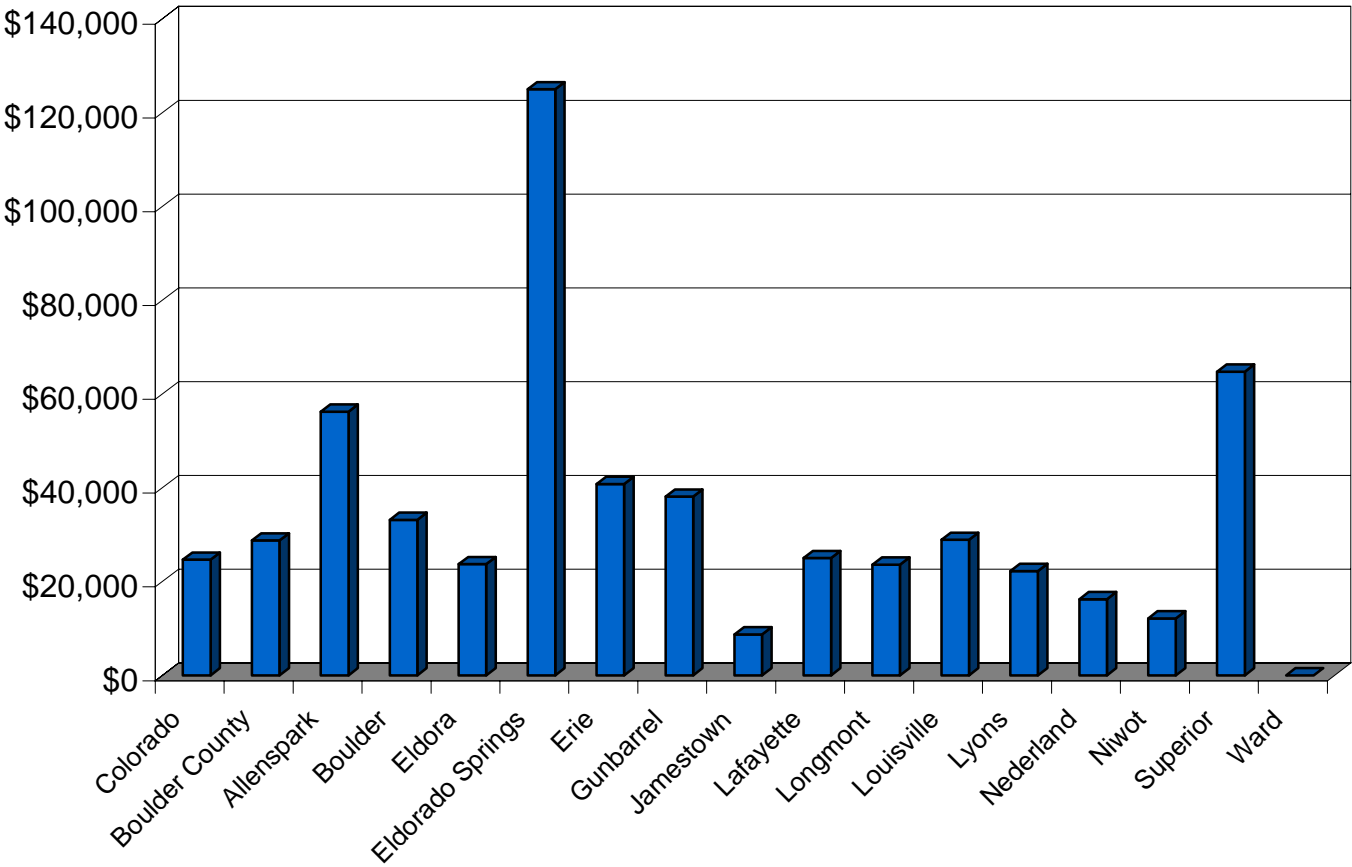

Median Household Income by Community – 65 to 74 Age Group 1999



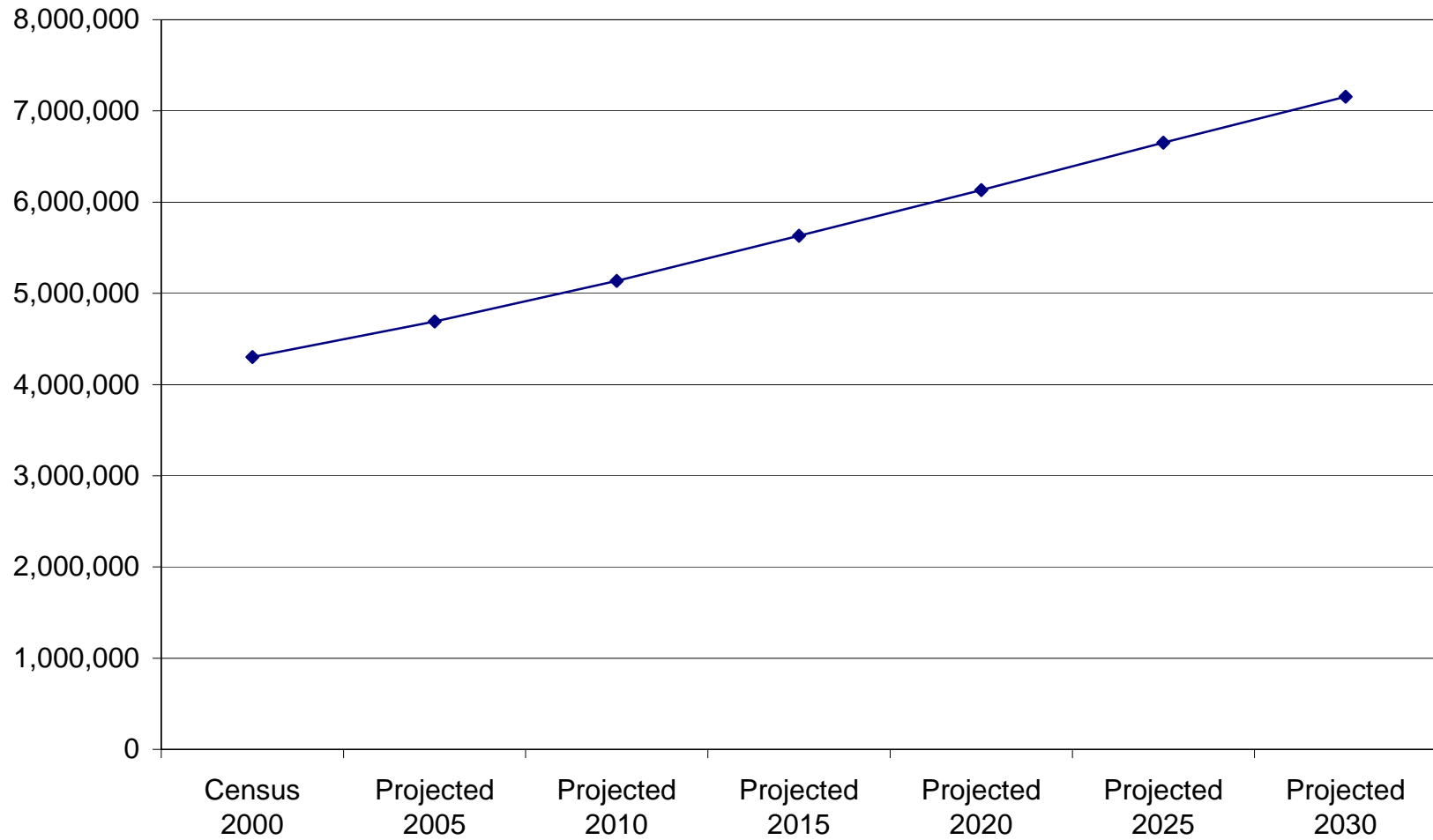

Median Household Income by Community – 75 and Over Age Group 1999



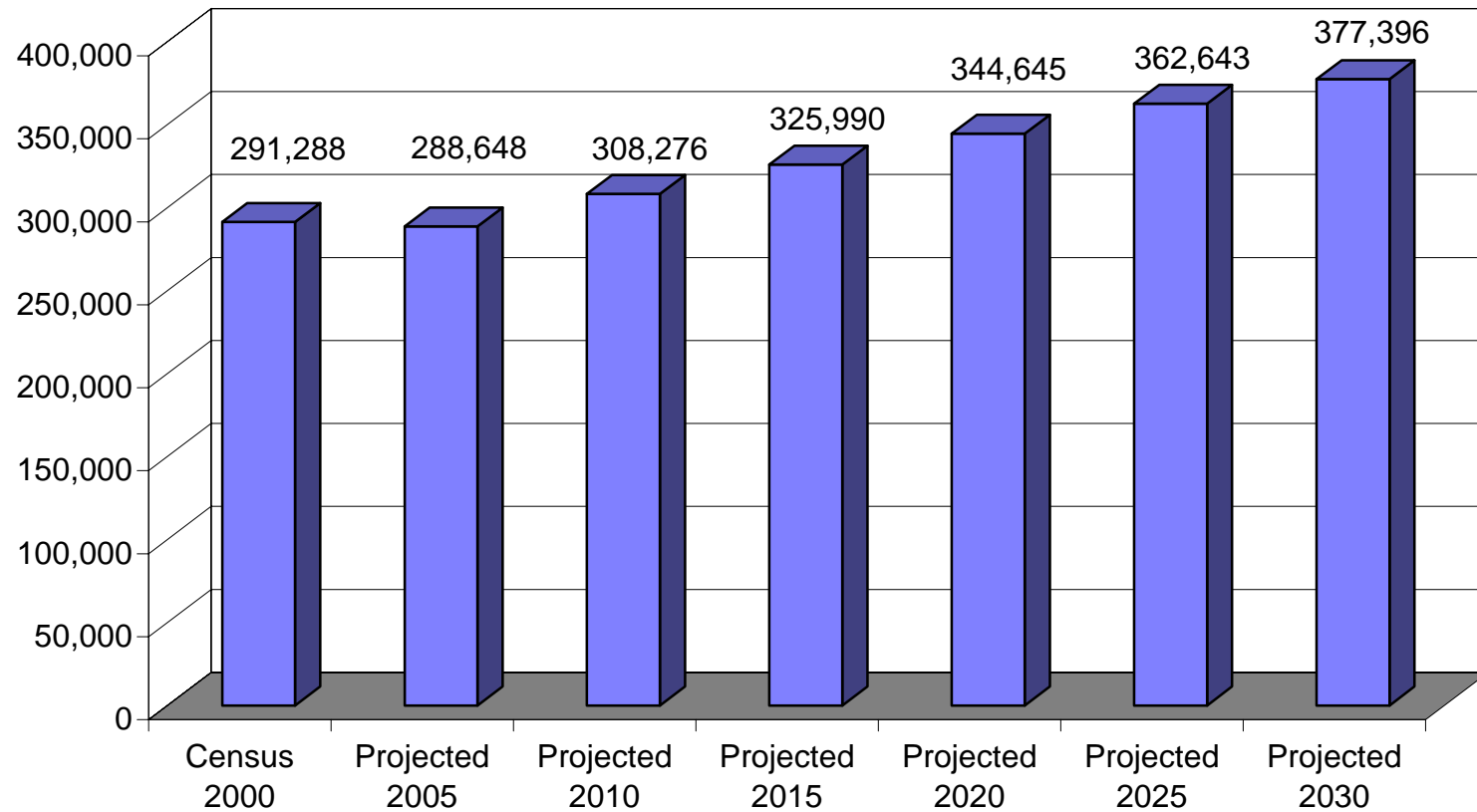

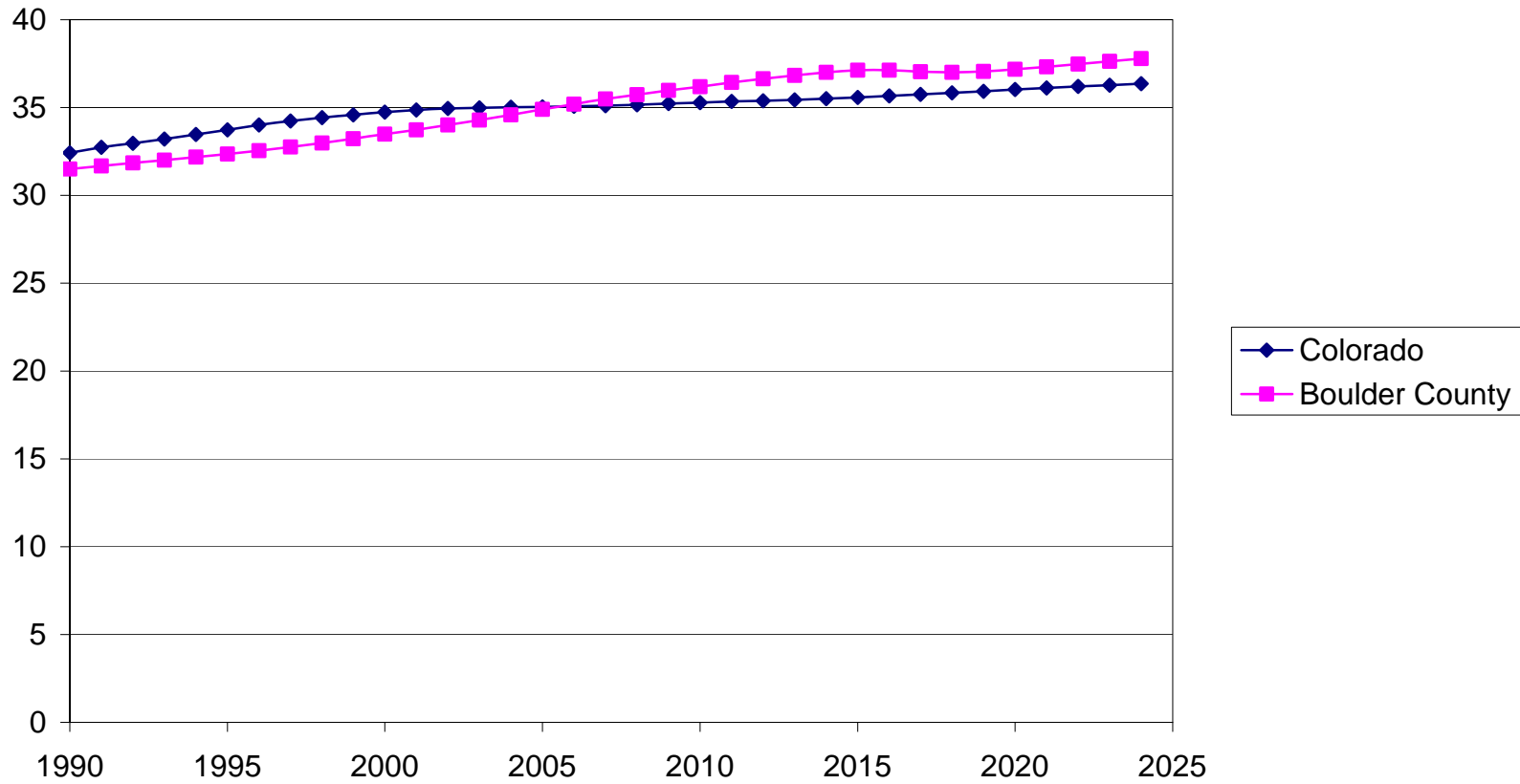
Projected Boulder County Population – All Ages 2005 – 2030

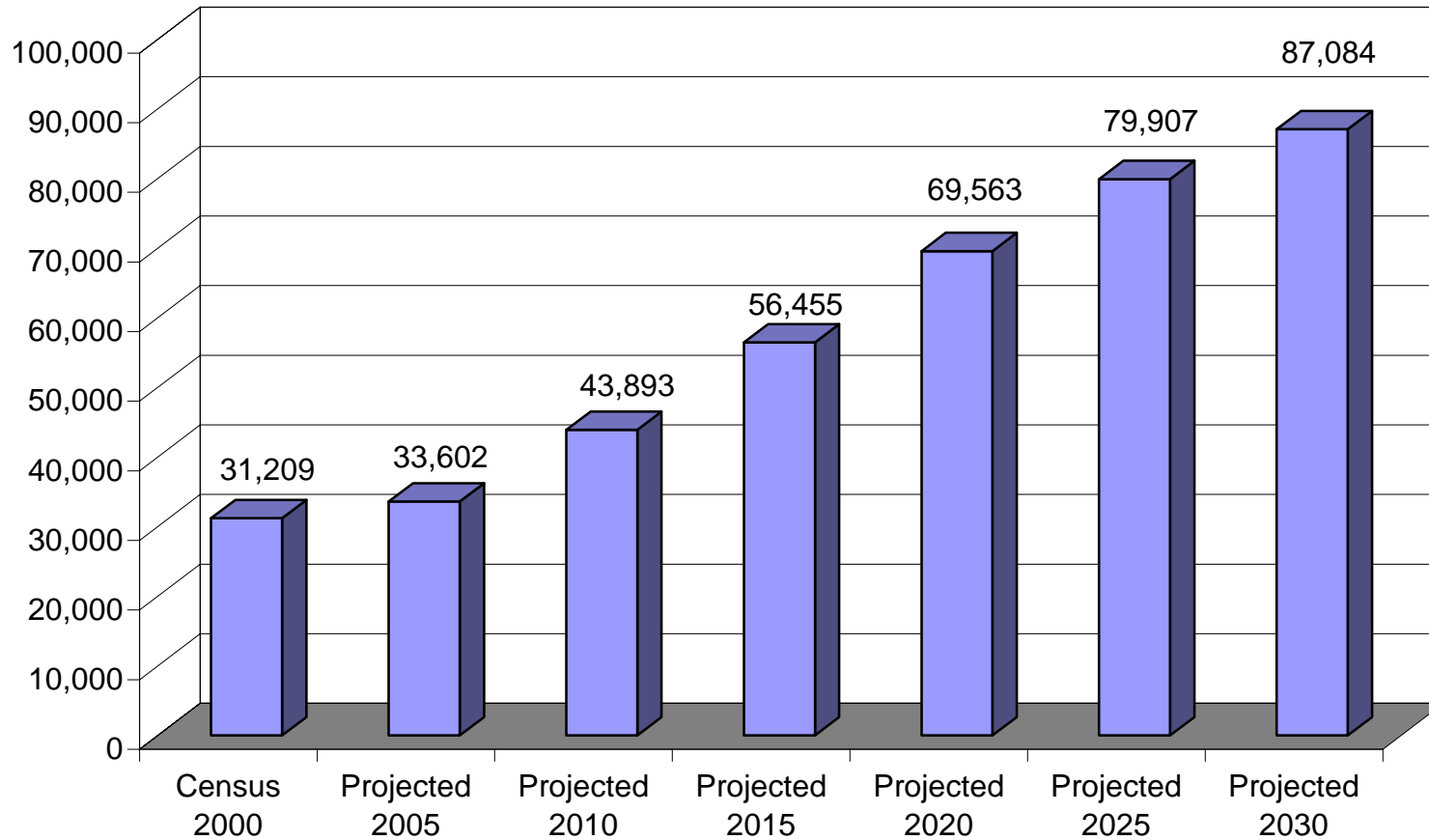

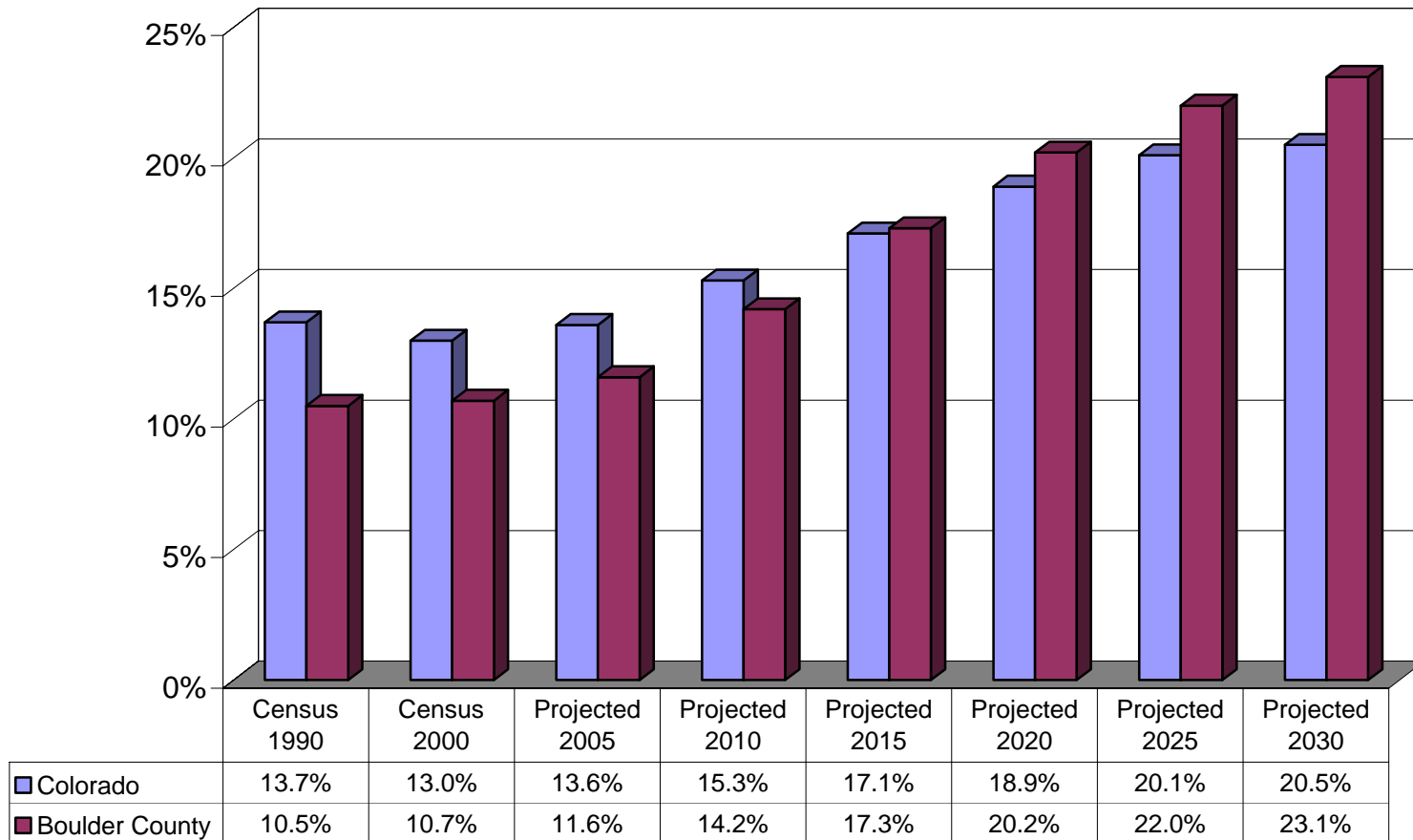

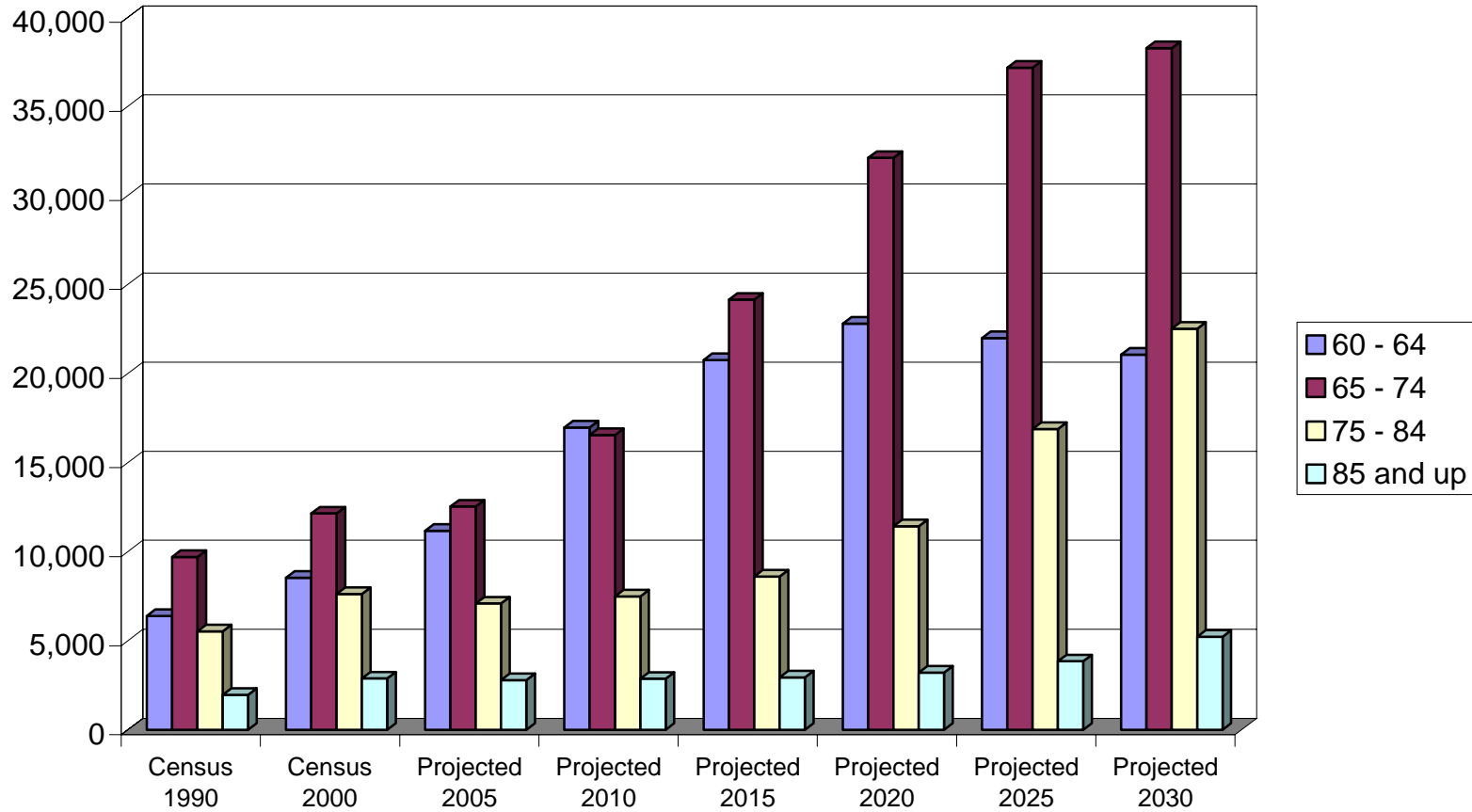
Projected Colorado and Boulder County 60+ Percent of Total Population 2005 – 2030

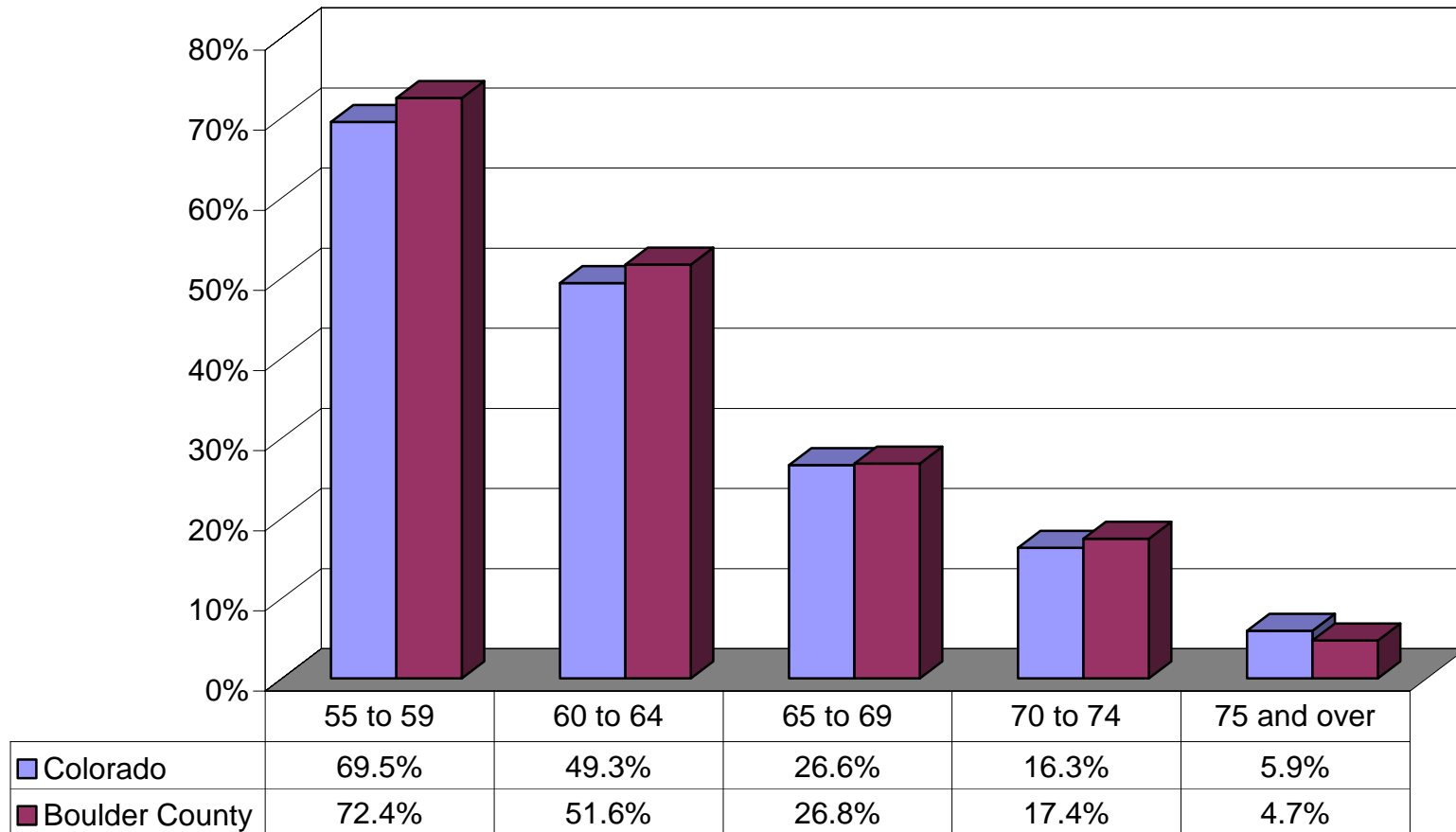
Projected Boulder County 60+ Population by Age Group 2005 – 2030

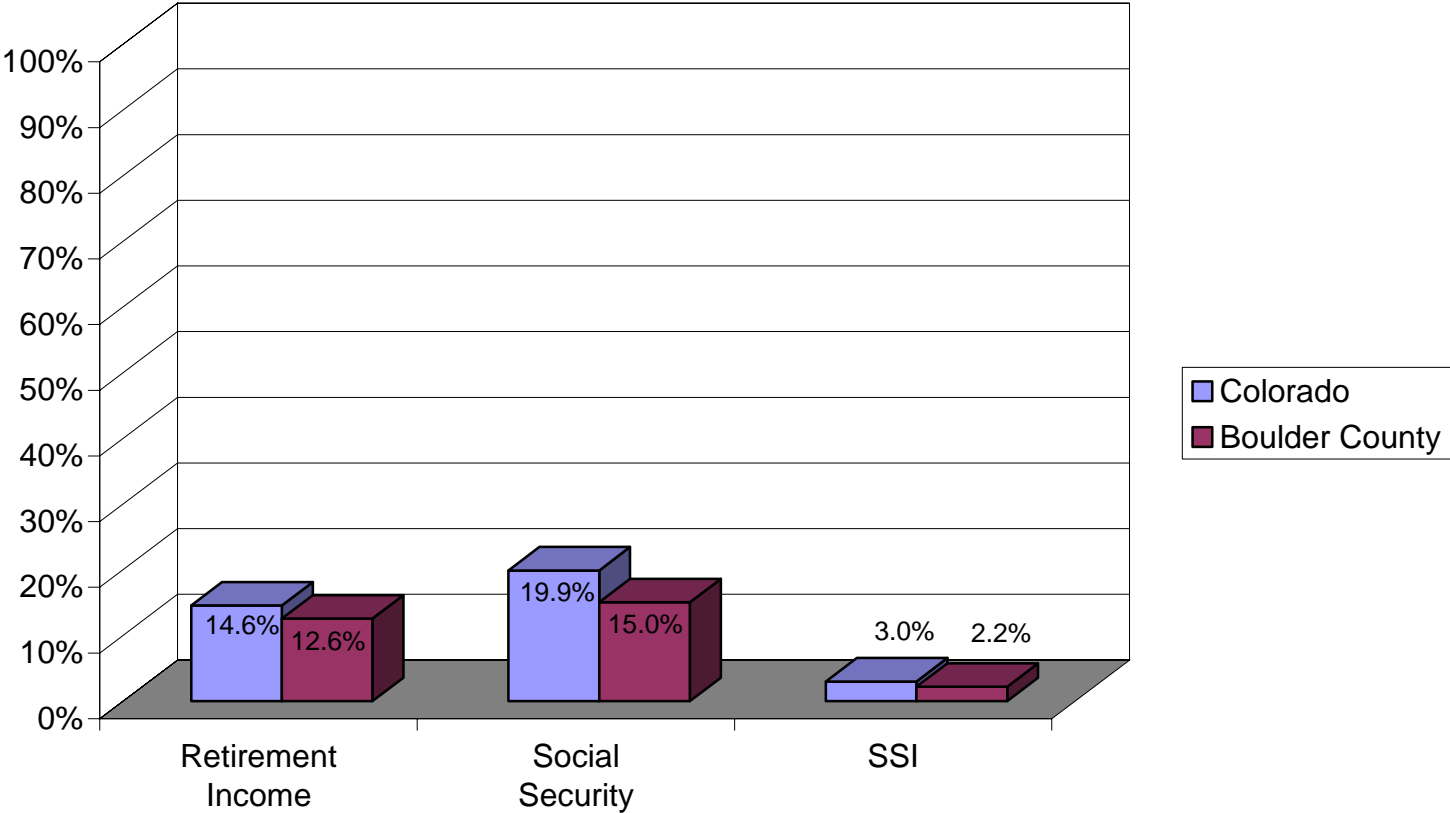

Percent of Boulder County 55+ Population Employed by Age Group



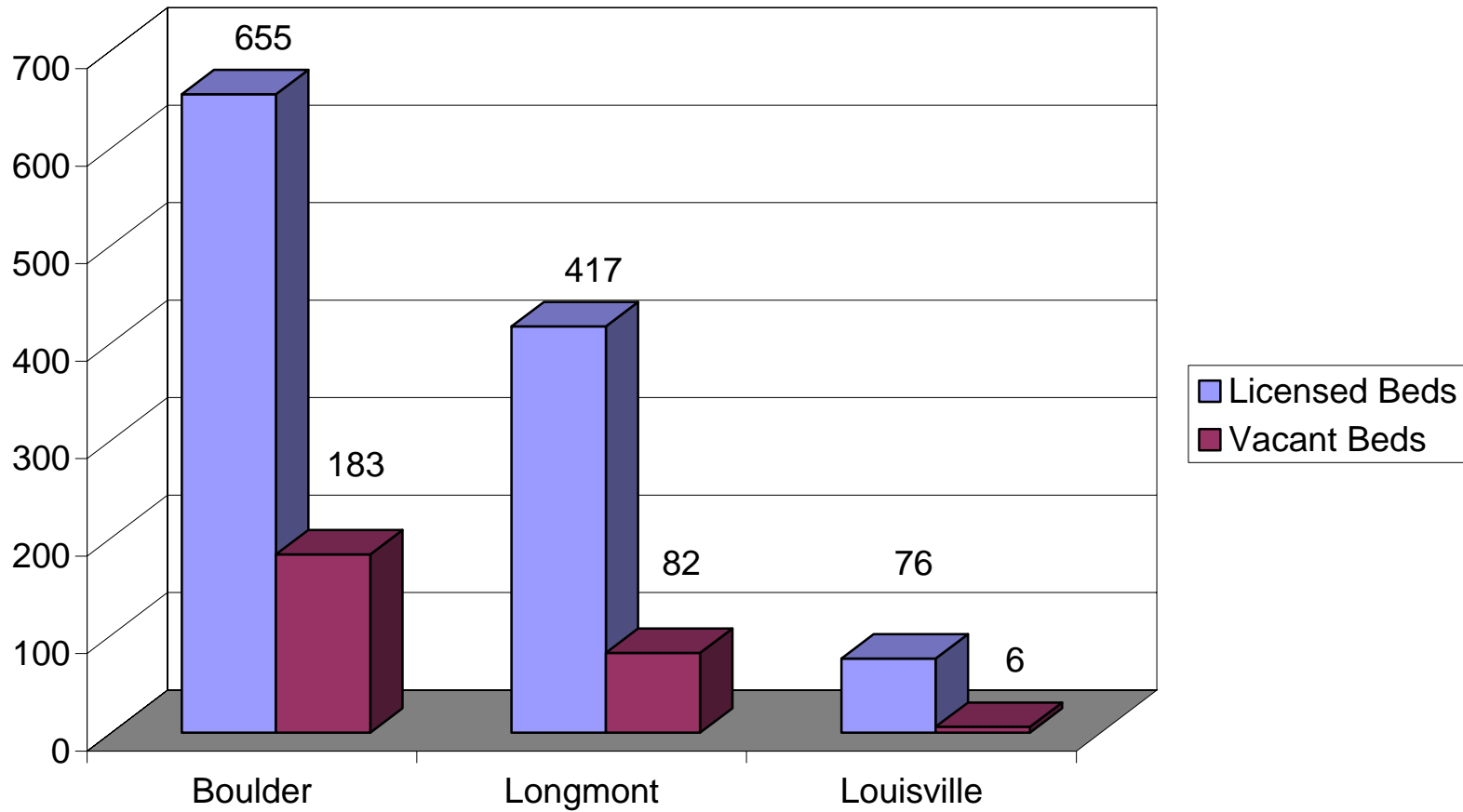

Boulder County Percent of Households with Selected Income Types



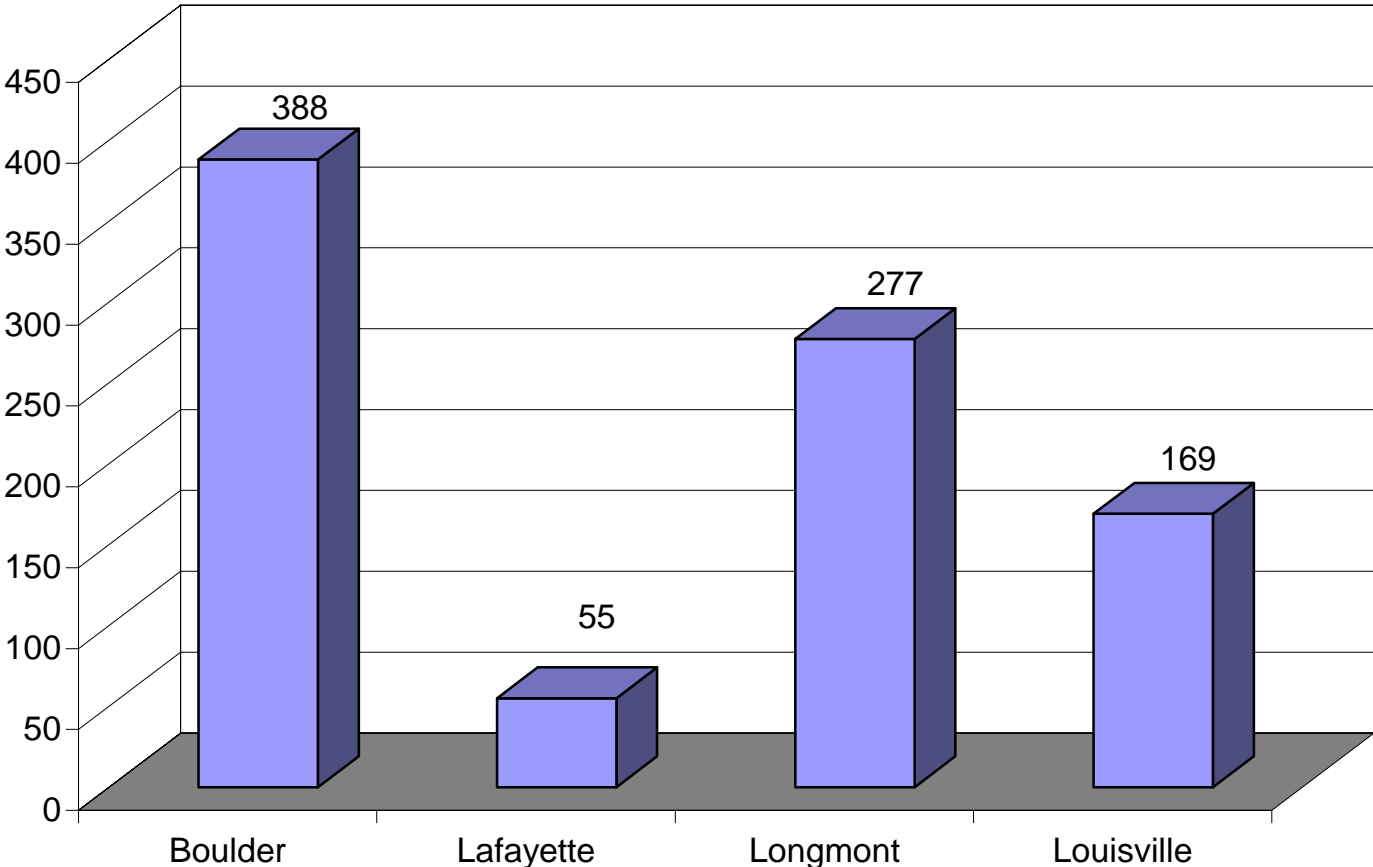

Boulder County Nursing Home Beds by Community



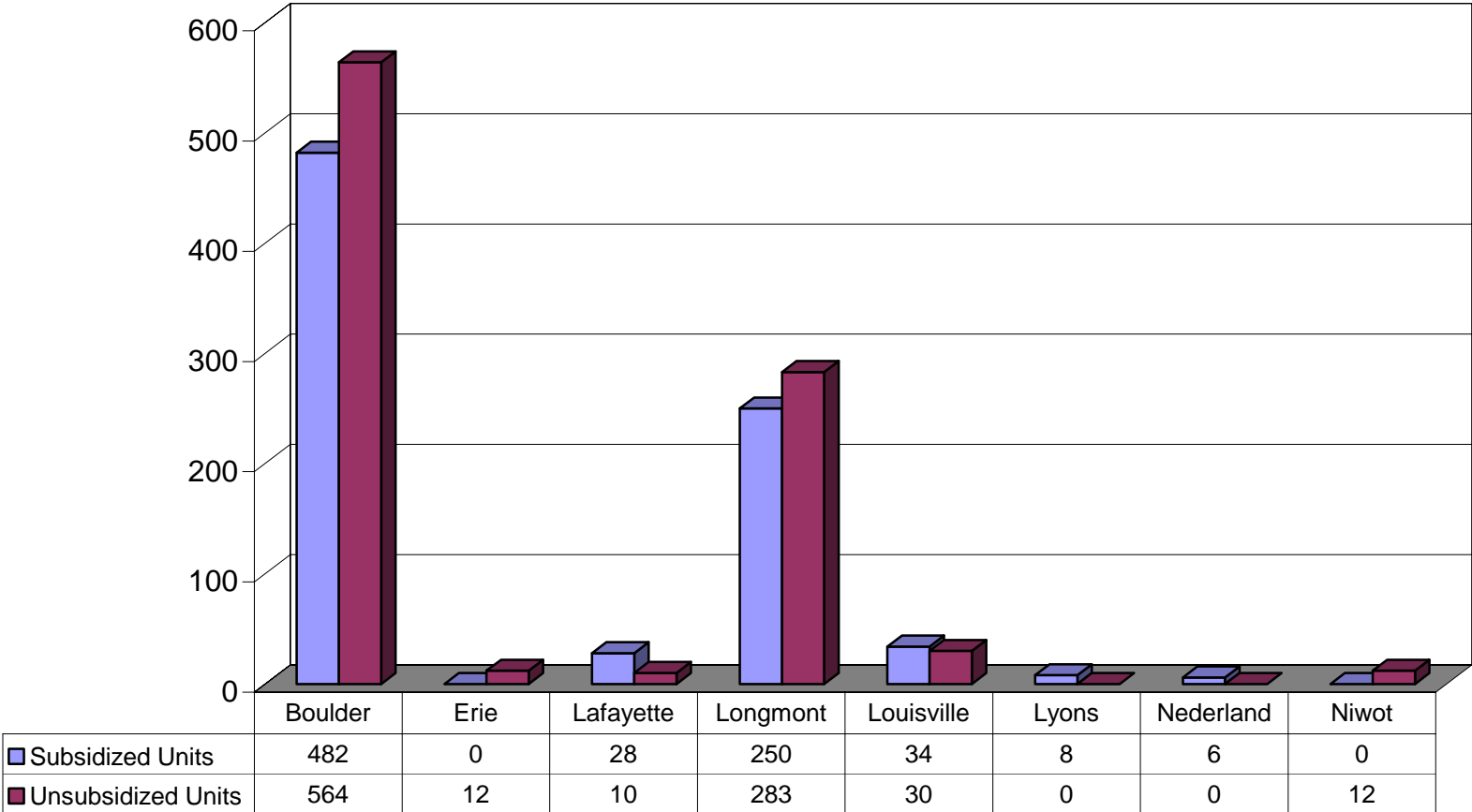

Suicide Among Older Adults

The highest risk for suicide death is found among older adults – even though the actual number of suicide deaths among the aged remains low as this age group is small compared to the middle-aged. Among all age-gender groups, white males over the age of 80 are at the greatest risk. Most older adults who die from suicide are white and not married (e.g., single, widowed or divorced). Depression has been found in 71% of completed suicide victims between the ages of 75 and 92. Another important factor in up to a third of suicides among older people is the presence of chronic physical illness. Older adults can also be distinguished by their choice of a suicide method. Compared with other age groups, they are more likely to use firearms, which more often result in death.⁴⁴ Challenges faced by older people include: declining physical health, multiple life losses (e.g., retirement, widowhood, financial changes), increasing social isolation and higher rates of depression.⁴⁵ Older adults who are more susceptible to suicide appear more likely to experience a sense of hopelessness in the face of these life changes, when compared to people of other groups.⁴⁶ In the weeks preceding their deaths, older adults often contact a primary care doctor, rather than a mental health specialist. Since older adults who are at highest risk of suicide commonly have diagnoses of depression, improved screening and treatment for depression among older adults should be promoted in primary-care practice settings.⁴⁷

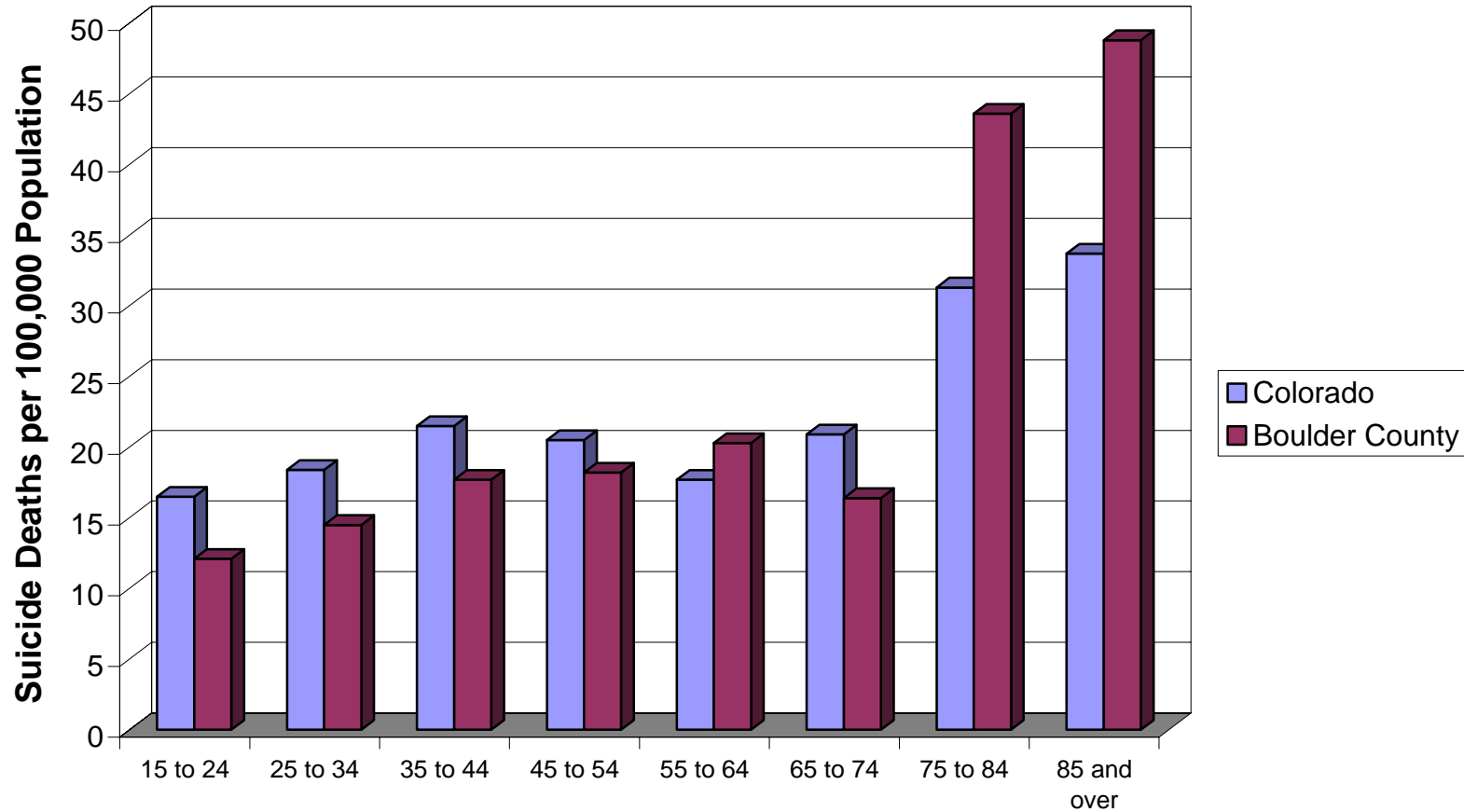

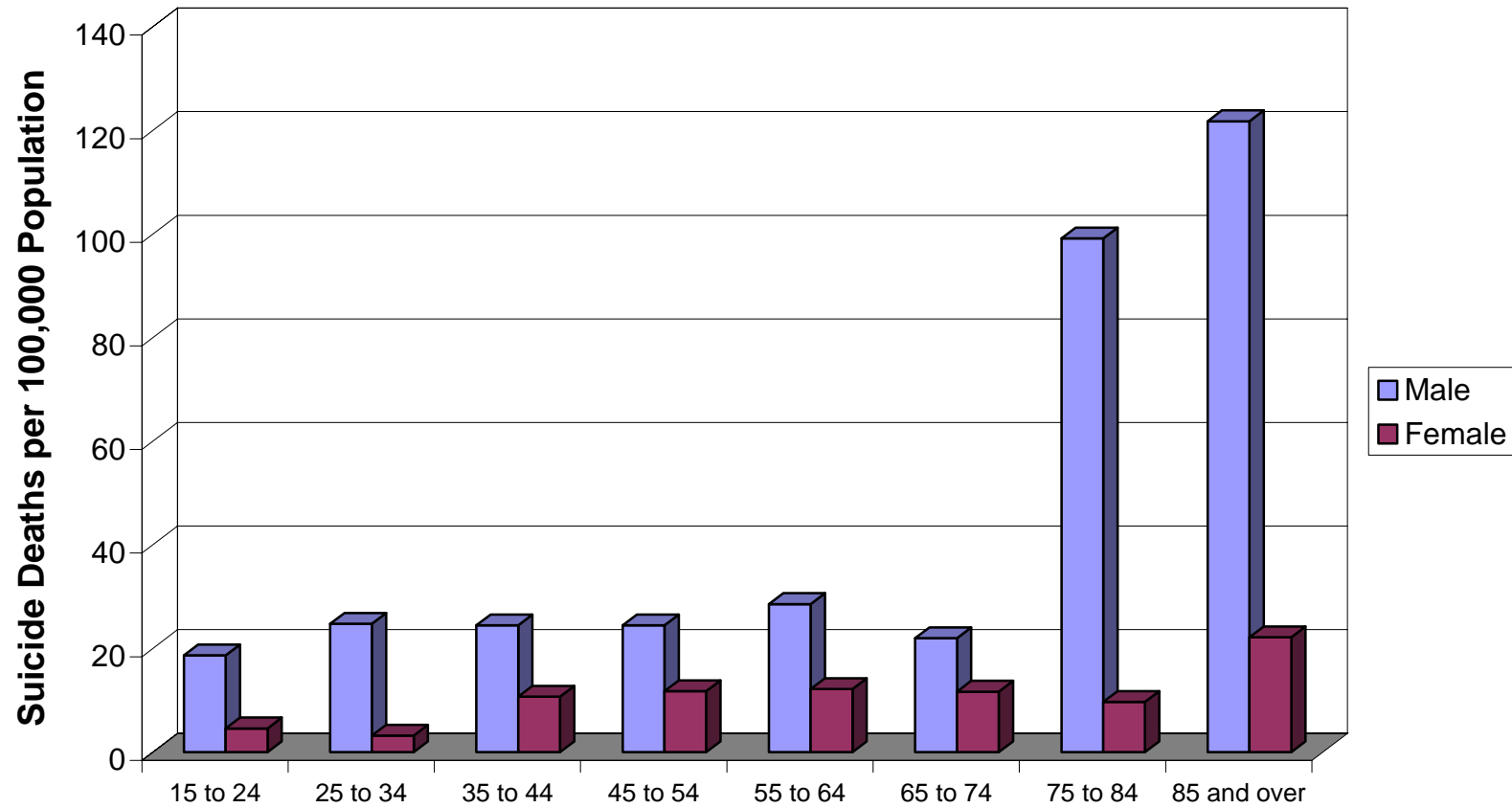
