NOTE: A temporary liquor license permit may issued only if a completed application for transfer of ownership along with all required documentation and associated fees has been submitted to the Boulder County Liquor Licensing Clerk.

An Affidavit of Transfer and Statement of Compliance signed by both Applicant and the Licensee must be submitted with application packet.

Applicant must have legal possession of the premises.

A temporary liquor license permit is valid for no more than one hundred twenty days from the date of issuance and is automatically void upon completion of the transfer of ownership and issuance of a new permanent liquor license in the name of the above applicant by the Colorado Division of Liquor Enforcement and the Boulder County Commissioners (Local Licensing Authority) through the Boulder County Clerk's office.

This permit may be canceled, revoked, or summarily suspended if the Local or State Licensing Authority determines there is probably cause to believe that the transferee has violated any provision of the Colorado Liquor/Beer Code or has violated any rule or regulation adopted by the Local or State Licensing Authority or has failed to truthfully disclose those matters required pursuant to the transfer to the transfer application forms.
