

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-90

A Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Boulder County approving a ballot title for the November 8, 2016 general election for an increase in the Boulder County ad valorem property tax mill levy to provide funding for road and bridge projects within the municipalities in Boulder County and rehabilitation of paved public subdivision roads in unincorporated Boulder County.

Recitals:

A. At the request of a Boulder County citizens group, the Board of County Commissioners of Boulder County ("the Board") adopted Resolution No. 2016-89, referring an issue to the November 8, 2016, general election ballot.

B. The Board desires to determine the ballot title for the issue referred for placement on the ballot for the November 8, 2016, general election.

C. Pursuant to Sections 30-11-103.5 and 31-11-111(3), C.R.S., as amended, the Board must fix a ballot title according to the following guidelines: consider the public confusion that might be caused by a misleading title; avoid a title for which the general understanding of the effect of a "yes" or "no" vote would be unclear; no conflict with titles selected for any other measure that will appear on the County ballot in the same election; and the title shall correctly and fairly express the true intent and meaning of the measure.

D. The Board finds that the ballot title set forth below meets the statutory guidelines.

Therefore, the Board resolves:

1. In accordance with the statutory guidelines, the Board fixes the following ballot title for the referred issue:

COUNTY ISSUE (Road and Bridge Mill Levy Increase):

SHALL BOULDER COUNTY TAXES BE INCREASED \$5.5 MILLION ANNUALLY (FIRST FULL FISCAL YEAR DOLLAR INCREASE IN 2017) THROUGH AN INCREASE IN BOULDER COUNTY'S AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX MILL LEVY OF 0.785 MILLS, FOR FIFTEEN YEARS TO AND INCLUDING DECEMBER 31, 2031, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ROAD AND BRIDGE PROJECTS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITIES IN BOULDER COUNTY AND REHABILITATION OF PAVED PUBLIC LOCAL ACCESS SUBDIVISION ROADS IN UNINCORPORATED BOULDER COUNTY, SUCH INCREASE IN PROPERTY TAX REVENUES TO BE IN EXCESS OF THAT WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE BE PERMITTED UNDER SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S., EACH YEAR WITHOUT SUCH INCREASE; AND SHALL THE REVENUES AND EARNINGS ON THE INVESTMENT OF THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAX, REGARDLESS OF AMOUNT, CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE AND A PROPERTY TAX REVENUE CHANGE; ALL AS MORE PARTICULARLY SET FORTH IN BOARD OF

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' RESOLUTION NO. 2016-89.

2. The Board shall take further action to finally certify the ballot measure and ballot title, together with any others that may be approved, to the November 8, 2016 general election ballot on or before September 9, 2016.

A motion to approve this Resolution 2016-90 was made by Commissioner Domenico, seconded by Commissioner Gardner, and passed by a 3-0 vote.
