

RESOLUTION 2015-123

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2015 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF BOULDER, COLORADO, FOR THE 2016 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Boulder has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is as follows:

WHEREAS, the 2015 valuation for assessment for the County of Boulder, as certified by the County Assessor is \$6,858,961,000; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the requirements for anticipated expenditures as well as anticipated revenues from other sources for 2016, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that for the year of 2015 valuations, the proper mill levy, which shall be collected in 2016 by the Treasurer of the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the County, shall be 24.805 mills, less a temporary mill levy credit of 2.181 mills, for a total of 22.624 mills.

The mill levy shall be distributed as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BOULDER, COLORADO:

That for the purpose of meeting general operating expenses of the County of Boulder during the 2016 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 24.805

mills, less a temporary mill levy credit of 2.181 mills, upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the County for the year 2015.
