1. Card key is to only be used by the individual recipient. Any individual found sharing will have his/her shelter access terminated immediately.

2. Never let anyone else into the shelter; each person should use their card key for access.
3. Boulder County will monitor individual use of the shelters through the card key access. Reports will be pulled periodically to determine frequency of use to insure that those signed up are using the shelters and not just storing their bikes.
4. The shelters are designed for regular use. Individuals not using the shelter enough will have their access deactivated. Users are expected to access the shelter at least once every two weeks, although depending upon public demand this frequency could increase.
5. Report lost or stolen cards immediately so they can be deactivated. New cards can be issued.
6. Only one bike may be stored per user per shelter at any one time.
7. Report lost or stolen cards immediately so they can be deactivated. New cards can be issued for a cost of \$5.
8. Only one bike may be stored per user per shelter at any one time.
9. Report any technical problems with accessing the inside of the shelters immediately to Boulder County by calling 303-441-3900. Boulder County reserves the right to have up to 24 hours to respond to a problem. Boulder County is not responsible for any related issues with users not being able to access the shelter.
10. Users are expected to keep the shelter clean and free of trash. It is acceptable to store helmets, lights, panniers, other saddle bags and trailers as long as these items do not interfere with others using the shelter.
11. Boulder County has the right to remove any personal property deemed abandoned.
12. Boulder County has the right to terminate an individual's access to any shelter at its sole discretion.
13. Terms and conditions can change without notice.
