Yard Reopening!

Nederland Area Sort Yard to Reopen on Fridays and Saturdays in October

Location: 286 Ridge Rd just north of the town of Nederland off of the Peak-to-Peak Highway

- This site will be open on Fridays and Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. during the last four weekends of October (Open on Oct. 7, 8, 14, 15, 21, 22, 28, 29).
- Closed Sunday-Thursday
- Landowners are encouraged to begin cutting and staging material now in preparation for the limited Friday and Saturday reopening.

Yard Open!

Allenspark Area Sort Yard is Open

Location: Peak-to-Peak Highway north of Allenspark on the Boulder and Larimer county line

- This site is now open Tuesday-Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- It will not accept logs infested by mountain pine beetles until after Sept. 15.
- Logs infested with ips beetles and/or trees cut during defensible space projects are always accepted.
- The Allenspark area site is anticipated to remain open through Sat., Oct. 15.

Community Benefits:

Community Forestry Sort Yards were established by Boulder County to help landowners fight bark beetle infestations, create better defensible space and to help create healthier forest conditions in the foothills of the county. Two sort yard locations are open each summer on a rotating schedule to provide residents a convenient free of charge location to dispose of logs and slash cut from their land.
