Dog “Poop” Research & Recommendations

- Researched outreach programs via Internet.
- Observed dog poop signs and trash containers at Boulder, Superior, Louisville and Longmont parks.
- Discussed options for poop bags and signs with Parks employees.
 - Major barrier: Citizens are not picking up their poop bags and are leaving them on the trail.
- Summary and Recommendations: To be completed in January and article in Summer Newsletter.
- 2011 – PACE will work with KICP Ed Program on seasonal messages and brochure.

Fire Suppression Systems

- 2 on-site meetings with COB Fire Marshal on sprinkler system design, outside discharge points and standard operating procedures (Fire Dept and Contractors).
- Amended Fire Suppression BMPs with proper language
- Worked with CDPHE on guidance document for fire suppression discharges.
- When CDPHE issues the guidance document, PACE will post on website and discuss with Facilities Management.
