

The financial guidelines for eligibility for NFP are based upon the annual Health and Human Services Poverty Guidelines updated and published by the federal registry each year. Please use the guidelines below for referrals in 2009 and early 2010.

Persons in Family or Household	2009 HHS Poverty Guidelines	NFP Eligibility at 200% of Poverty Guidelines
1	\$10,830	N/A
2	14,575	\$29,150 (Single and pregnant with one child)
3	18,310	\$36,620 (Pregnant with twins or pregnant with one and sharing income with partner)
4	22,050	\$44,100 (Pregnant with triplets or pregnant with twins and sharing income with partner)
For each additional person, add	3,740	

For NFP: When calculating family size, always include the woman and the number of babies she expects to have—a woman pregnant with one child has a family size of 2; a woman pregnant with twins has a family size of 3; etc. If the woman has a partner with whom she shares income, include the partner as a member of the family. For example for a couple expecting one child, their family size = 3.
